



## Main Legislation & Guidance

1989 - Main Framework

2002 - Section 157 duty to safeguard Pupils

2004 - As above but for all organisations

### Legal Responsibilities under Section 175 (S157 – Independent Schools)

'Safeguarding & Promoting Welfare'- covers more than the contribution made to child protection in relation to individual children e.g. bullying, medical needs, school security etc

LEAs, Governing Bodies and establishments must have in place relevant policies and procedures

Must have DSP for child protection (and back-up person recommended)
DSP to update their cp training every two years

All staff to be inducted and receive updated training every three years Safe recruitment procedures

Must adhere to Guidance issued by Secretary of State

Not about increased individual liability. Legislation refers to making and having in place 'arrangements ......'
