

It's a proposed **trade agreement** between the European Union and the United States, which has the intention of promoting trade and multilateral economic growth.


- Companion agreement to the Trans-Pacific Partnership (TPP).
- The agreement is under ongoing negotiations.
- Its main three broad areas are market access, specific regulation, and broader rules and principles and modes of co-operation.
- Negotiations were meant to be finalized by the end of 2014, some renowned economists, assume it will not be finished until 2019 or 2020.

### LETS TAKE A LOOK MORE IN DEPTH...,

- The treaty mainly reduces barriers to trade for big business, things like food safety law, environmental legislation, banking regulations and the sovereign powers of individual nations.
- Reports on the negotiations, contents and proposals are classified from the public, and can be accessed only by authorized persons.
- Multiple leaks of proposed TTIP have caused controversy.
- Ratification: The 28 European member governments will have to approve the partnership. In the United States, both houses of the Congress will have to pass the agreement.
