



Changing laws

- the Georgia Legislature changed the state law so that pimping was no longer a misdemeanor but a felony, with prison sentences of up to 20 years, depending on the child's age.
- In 2011, they succeeded in winning passage of House Bill 200, Georgia's Human Trafficking Law, which again increased penalties for trafficking.
- This year, Gov. Nathan Deal of Georgia signed two new measures, which was on the November ballot and voters agreed to make this a law.
