- Situated in the Eastern-Southern part of the Arab Peninsula
- The highest mountain above 2000m is the mountain of Arabian peninsula 8,100 ft
- 600 miles of Red Sea Coast along the Red Sea and 1700 Miles of Persian Gulf along the Arabian Gulf

- The main location of the factory would be in Riyadh, the capitol. Due to the abundance of population there would be a large workforce. With a population of approximately 4.087 million people in 2004.

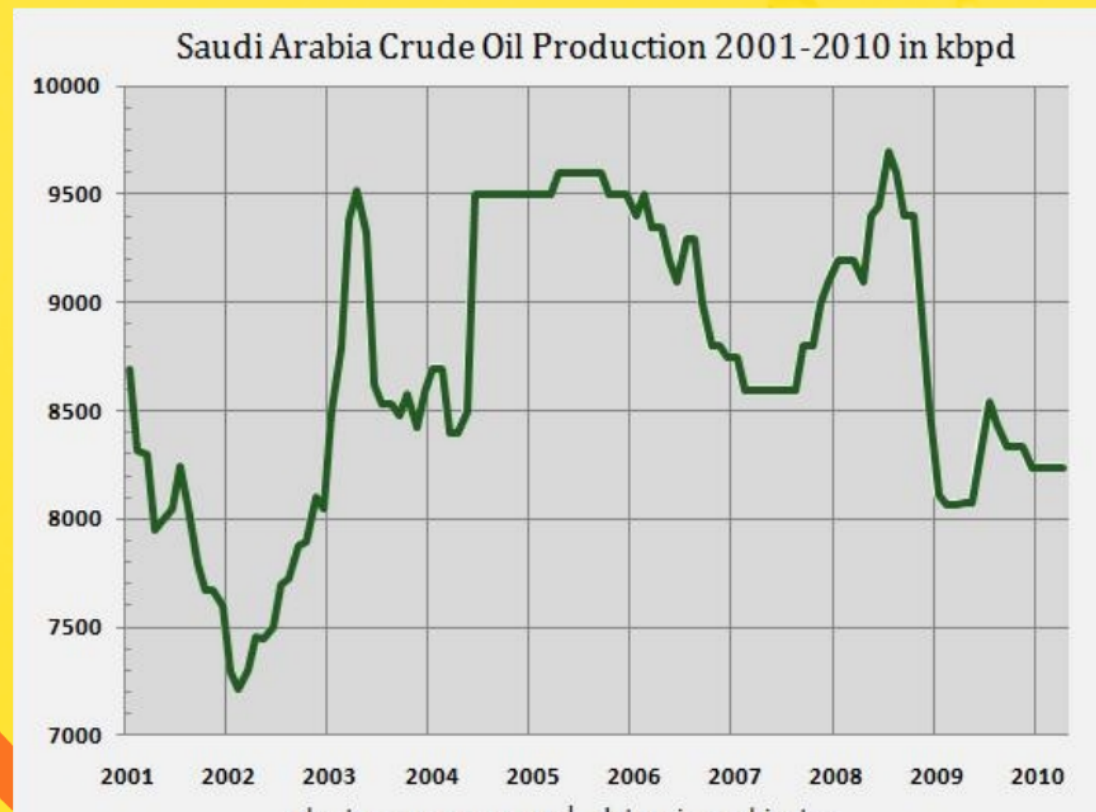
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- Saudi Arabia possesses 18 percent of the world's petroleum reserves and ranks as the largest exporter, or producer of petroleum.
