Doctors Without Borders was created in France in 1973 as a humanitarian international medical organization.

Doctors Without Borders or MSF was created by a team of journalists and doctors.

This team of doctors and journalists started Doctors Without Borders after volunteering with organizations like the Red Cross in war torn countries, mostly in the Nigerian Civil War. After volunteering with the Red Cross this team of Doctors witnessed people being hurt and starving and them not being given aid because the organization they were with saw their point of view and the side they were fighting for as wrong and the Red Cross refused to give them aid.

This team of doctors and journalists found it wrong that people who needed help were not getting it because of differing political and religious view. These doctors and journalists decided it would be best if they started their own organization that would only focus on giving aid to people and that they would completely ignore and political or religious view they had.

Doctors Without Borders has offices located in 20 different countries around the world.

Doctors Without Borders' decision to intervene in any country or crisis is based solely on an independent assessment of people's needs -- not on political, economic, or religious interests. MSF does not take sides or intervene according to the demands of governments or warring parties."
