Sentence structure to express hope using “ing verbs”

Subject	-Ing Verb	Complement
I	am hoping	For some good weather tomorrow
I	am hoping	For a good grade in <u>english</u>

Sentence Structure 2

Sentence structure to express hope using 'to' and 'that'.

Subject + Verb (Hope) + Complement

I hope **to** travel the world

They hope **not to** disappoint their parent

She hopes **that** she will get a scholarship in Europe

Mr. Brown hopes **that** it won't rain tonight.

Sentence structure to express hope **using verb tenses**

Subject	verb	Compement
I	hope	Rahmat found the place
I	hope	My brother passed the test
I	hope	Iwan is having a good time in Bali

Different Between Hope and Wish

Hope can be used to specify a desired outcome. For future hopes, the possibilities remain open, but for the past hopes, the outcome has usually been determined already.

Ex: I hope you can come to party on Saturday.

Wish is mostly commonly used in hypothetical (or imagined/unreal) situations.

Ex: I wish that you were here
