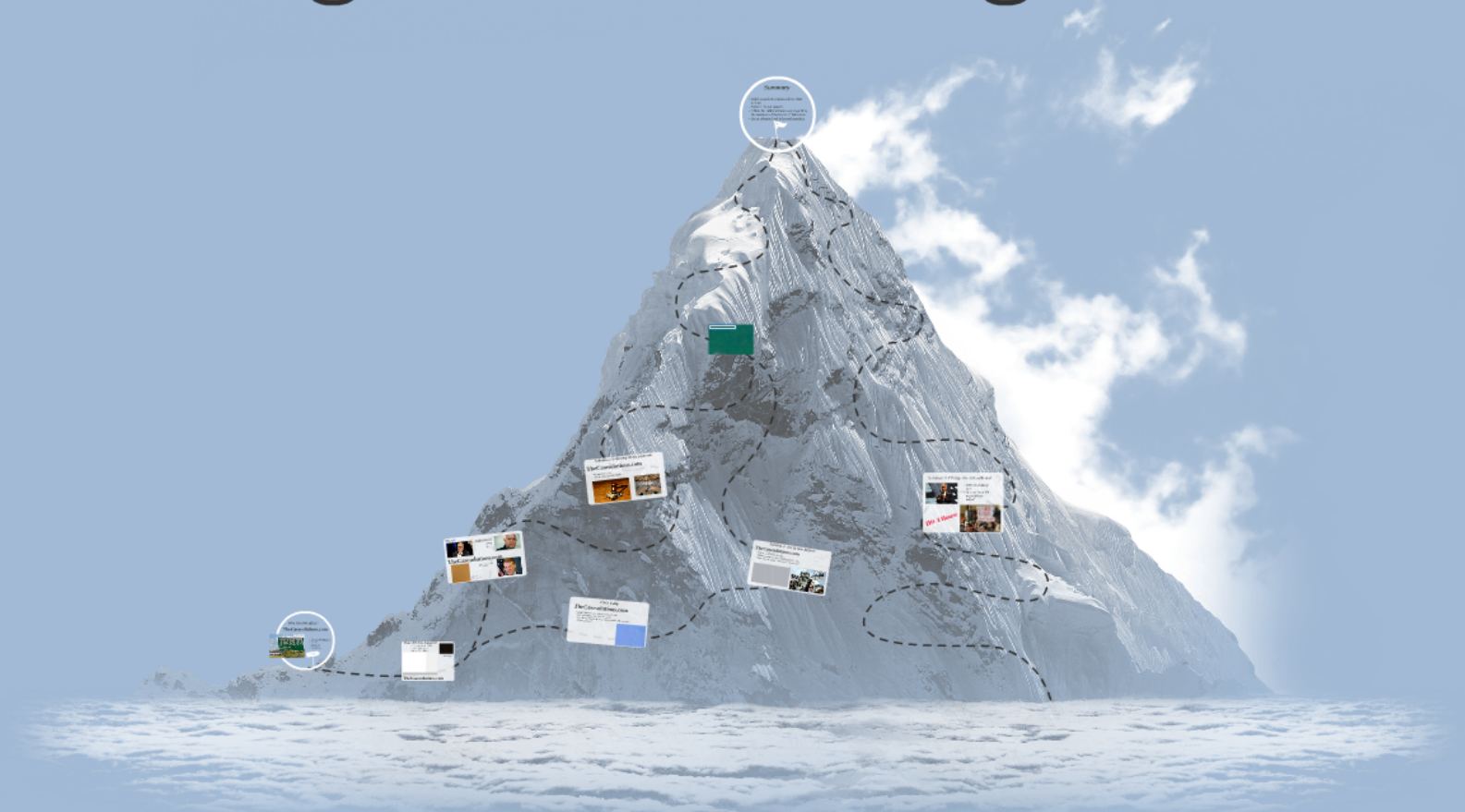

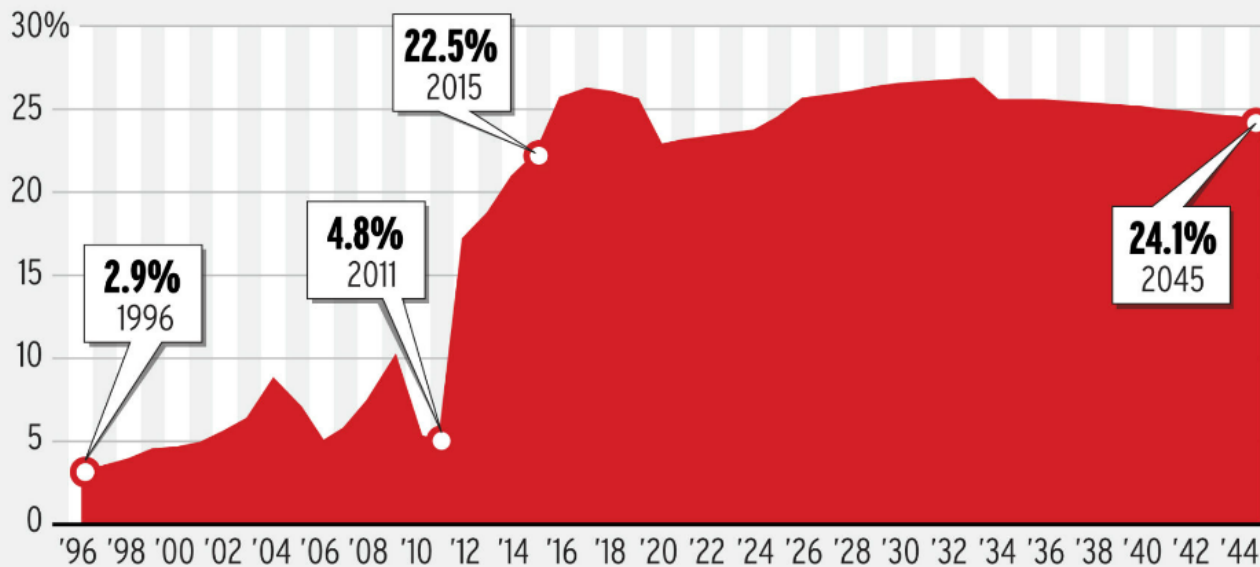
How did this happen?

THE EDGAR RAMP

Set artificially low in the '90s, required payments to the state pension funds accelerated dramatically in 2012 and will stay high for the next three decades.
