- Tallinn settled by **Finno-Ugric** people around **25 000 BC**
- The **Danes** conquered **Northern Estonia** in **1219**. They were about to **retreat** in a battle with **Tallinn** when a **red flag with a cross** fell into the bishops hands, which meant **gods support**. So they went on to win the battle
- In the **14th** century the Danish **sold** northern Estonia to the **Teutonic Order**.
- The Teutonic order weakened and the **Russians, Swedes, Danes, Poles and the Lithuanians** fought for Tallinn but it finally **surrendered to Russia**.
- **The soviet Union** started **changing** Tallinn and most people living there were Russian.
- Estonia including Tallinn finally became an **independent country in 1991**

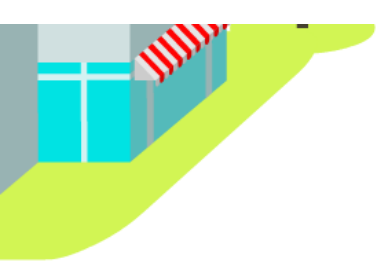
