

South African Climate Variations

"Classified as a semi-arid region, but has many variations of climate (SouthAfrica.Info, 2012)."

"In the Northwest region towards the Kalahari Desert, the summers are extremely hot and subject to icy conditions in the winter (SouthAfrica.Info, 2012)."

"The south-western corner of the country has a Mediterranean climate, with wet winters and hot, dry summers. Its most famous climatic characteristic is its wind that blows all year round from southeast or north-west (SouthAfrica.Info, 2012)."

"North of the Vaal River, the Highveld is better watered, and saved by its altitude from subtropical extremes of heat. Winters are cold, though snow is rare (SouthAfrica.Info, 2012)."

"One of the coldest places in the country is Sutherland, in the western Roggeveld Mountains, with midwinter temperatures as low as -15°C (SouthAfrica.Info, 2012)."

"The deep interior provides the hottest temperatures (SouthAfrica.Info, 2012)."

"Temperature and rainfall patterns vary in response to the movement of a high pressure belt that circles the globe between 25° and 30° south latitude during the winter and low-pressure systems that occur during summer (SA-Venues, 2013)."
