This University of Kentucky themed wedding will take place at 3 pm October 5, 2013. The ceremony will be held outdoors among vibrant fall colored trees at Spindletop Hall in Lexington, Kentucky. A flower girl will begin the ceremony by tossing orange rose petals down an aisle runner. Aisle facing chairs replacing church pews will adorn large, blue hydrangea floral markers at every other row. The bride will walk down the aisle in a lace gown, holding a bouquet of blue and white flowers with orange accents. Her bridesmaids will wear 'UK blue' dresses and hold small versions of the bride's bouquet. The maid of honor's bouquet is larger than the other bridesmaids yet smaller than the brides. The groom will await his bride under a pergola altar draped in baby's breath. He and his groomsmen will wear black suits and 'UK blue' ties.

The reception will immediately follow the ceremony. The 200 guests will be ushered inside to the banquet hall where they will be welcomed by 2 large floral arrangements creating a gateway to the after party. 20 round tables will seat 10 guests each for dinner.
