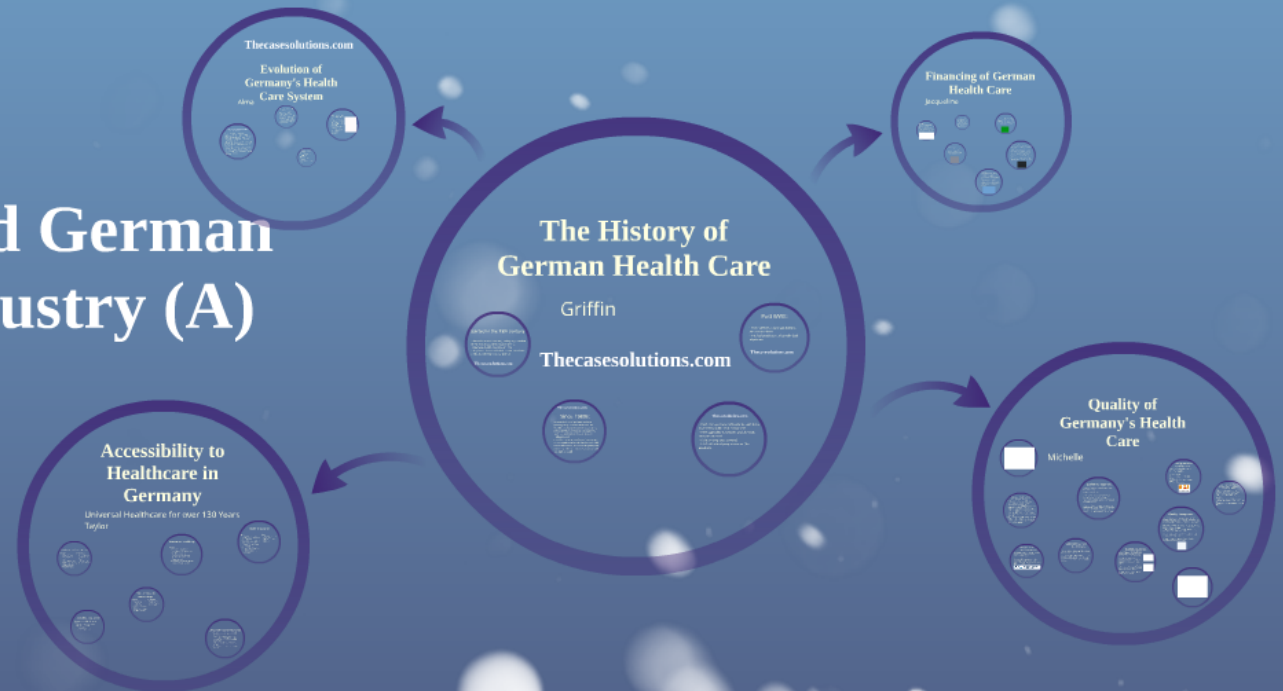


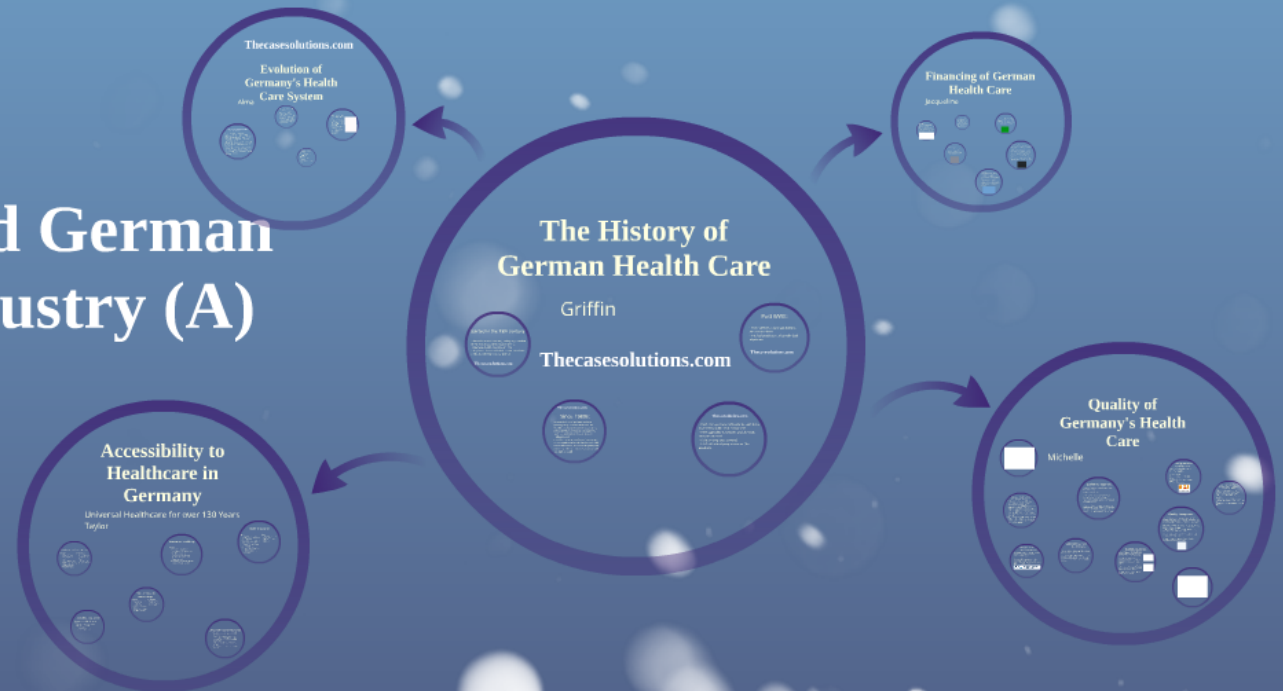

The Basic Law of 1949

- The reunification of Germany resulted in each state's government and by law the public insurance for all citizens in every state that enforces the same regulations.
- There is a universal coverage in any part of the country along with some health care are taken into account with insurance medical attention.

The two divisions were East Germany and West Germany. East Germany created a health system that was state run with physician employees. West Germany on the other hand created a system that was less reliant on the government.
