- Virupaksha Temple (Hampi)
Description: Originally started out as a small shrine, which grew into a massive complex
- Harmandir Sahib/ Golden Temple (Amritsar)
Description: Most important religious place to Sikhs (a temple)
- Ajanta Caves
Description: Monuments carved out from caves; depicts history
- Taj Mahal (Agra)
Description: Mausoleum of solid marble, surrounded by other features such as reflective pools and ornamental gardens.


