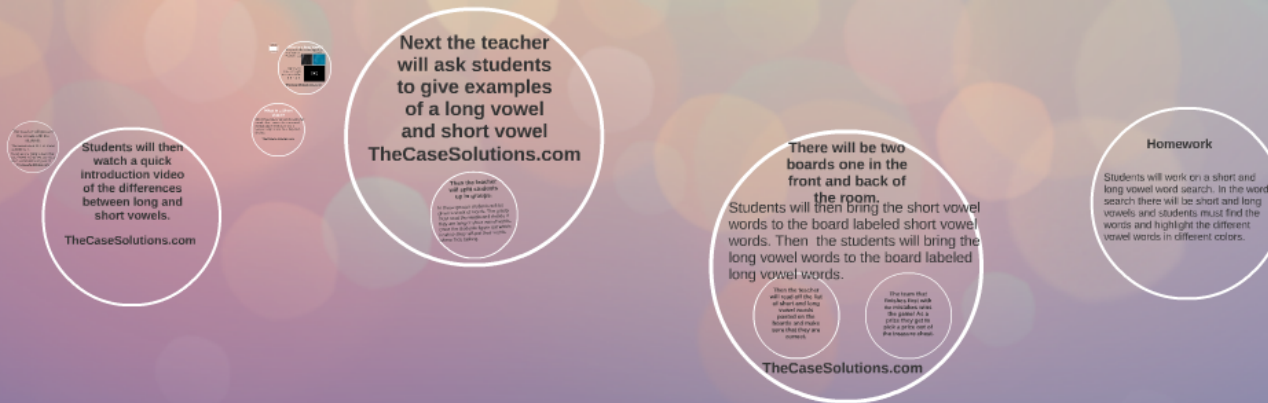
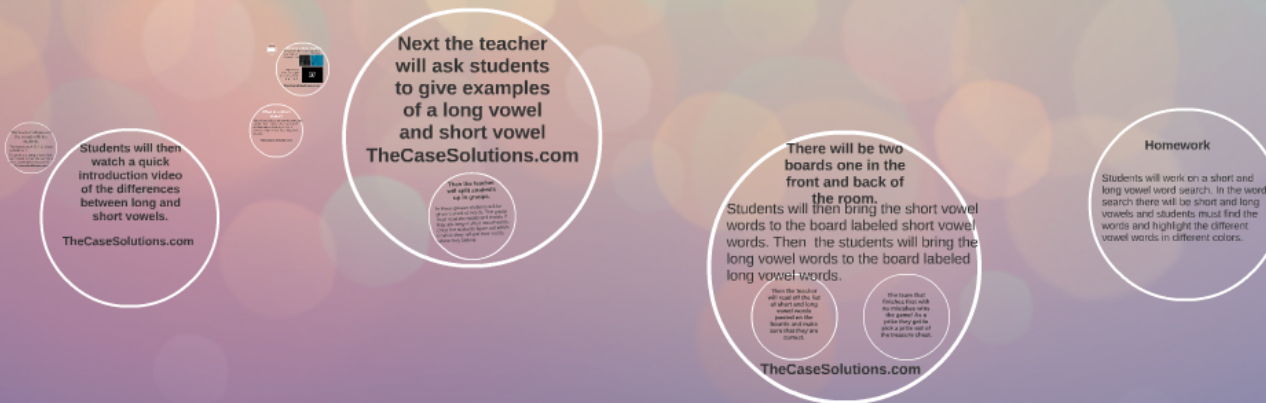


Universal Display Corporation: Go Long or Short?

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What is a Short Vowel?

Short Vowel does not say its own letter sound. Short vowels have a curved symbol above them \check{a} , \check{e} , \check{i} , \check{o} , \check{u} . Some examples are bun, bop, bed, bin, bat.

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There will be two boards one in the front and back of the room.

Students will then bring the short vowel words to the board labeled short vowel words. Then the students will bring the long vowel words to the board labeled long vowel words.

Then the teacher will read off the list of short and long vowel words posted on the boards and make sure that they are correct.

The team that finishes first with no mistakes wins the game! As a prize they get to pick a prize out of the treasure chest.

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
