Who Can Donate Blood?
Anyone can donate blood,
as long as they pass the screen test
and are not positive for any illnesses that
can harm people.

How Much Blood Do They Need?
An adult, 100cc (3.5 ounces) of blood is all that is needed to replace the blood lost during a blood donation. The amount of blood lost is replaced within a few days.



Where Are They Found?
They are found in every Province
and Territory throughout Canada.

How Much Blood Does Someone Need?
The following chart shows.

How much blood does it take to save a life?

100 cc (3.5 oz)	1 pint (16 oz)
200 cc (7 oz)	2 pints (32 oz)
300 cc (10.5 oz)	3 pints (48 oz)
400 cc (14 oz)	4 pints (64 oz)
500 cc (17.5 oz)	5 pints (80 oz)
600 cc (21 oz)	6 pints (96 oz)
700 cc (24.5 oz)	7 pints (112 oz)
800 cc (28 oz)	8 pints (128 oz)
900 cc (31.5 oz)	9 pints (144 oz)
1000 cc (35 oz)	10 pints (160 oz)

(Note: 1 pint = 16 ounces)

What Does it Do?
The Canadian Blood Services donates
blood to those who need it.

When are the Don'ts Done?
The blood can be used once it has been stored
properly for up to 42 days, depending on the
type of blood product.



Should I get tested?
To get tested, call your doctor
or call the Blood Services and set
up an appointment with them, or
you can go to a clinic.

Get the Blood?
A 100 cc donation may help an adult to receive
another 100 cc of blood.
A 100 cc donation may help a child to receive
10 cc of blood.
