History of the problem I

- 2003: Cisco Systems filed a lawsuit against Huawei on 21 counts of copyright and other violations with respect to routers and switching products, including operating source code.
- The US government and American companies became increasingly wary of Huawei's presence in the country, concerned that it might be undertaking espionage activities for the Chinese government.
- Market opportunities further narrowed when the National Security Agency warned AT&T to suspend purchasing equipment from Huawei, given national security concerns.
