

## Countable and Uncountable words


**Countable words**  
Countable words have singular and plural forms, in plural form they can be counted (1 apple, 2 apples, 100 apples). We also use *many* and *few* with countable words (100 friends - many friends).

**Uncountable words**  
Uncountable words can only be used in singular form (milk, money) and can't be counted (1 milk, 2 milk, 1 money, 2 money). Uncountable words use *much*, *little* (100 money - much money, little milk left).
