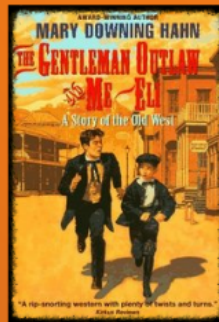
Scenery from the town of Durango.

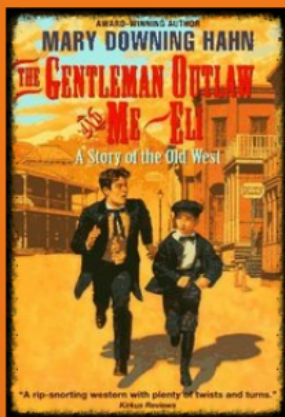
