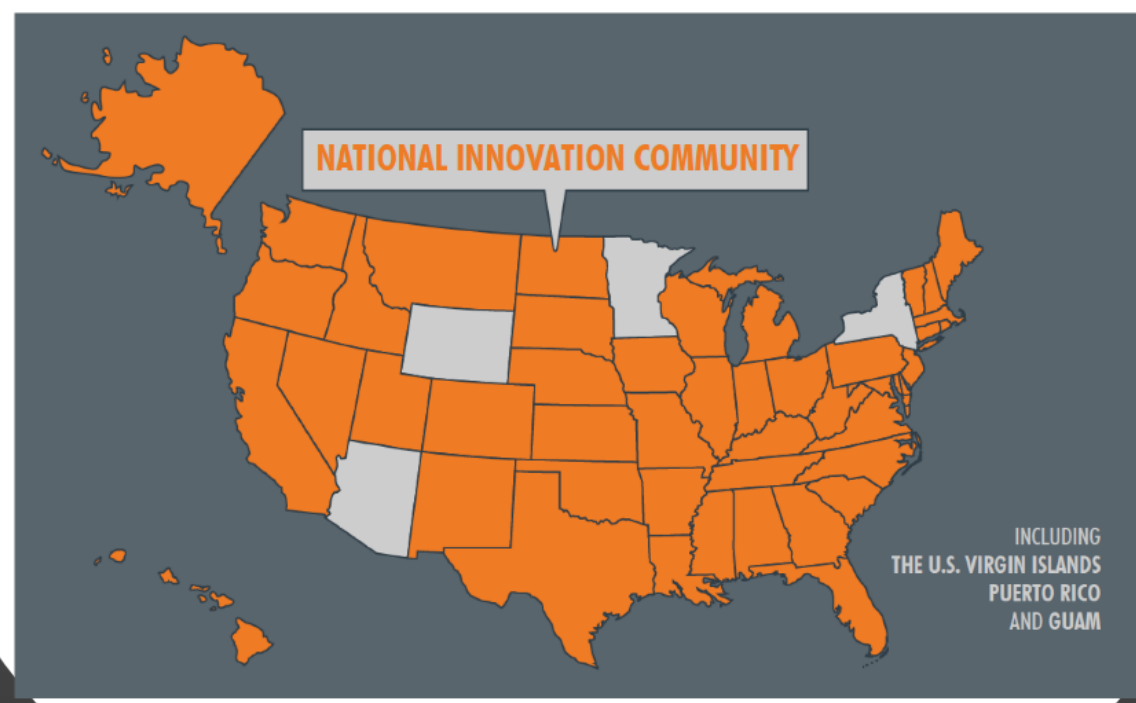


*North Carolina's Governor McCrory
