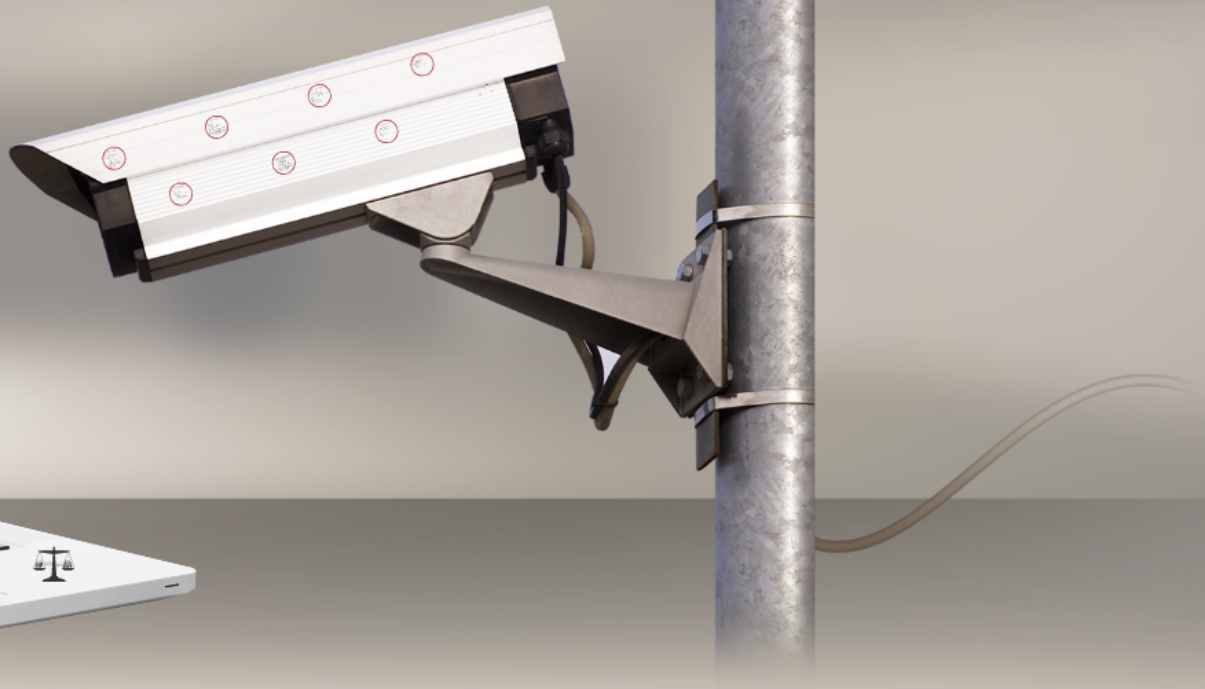



Keyworth/Perkins – focused on technology innovations
