TopCoder adopted a model to create solutions for clients by contracting with community members, running competitions, and providing consulting services. The company broke down the software development process into seven distinct tasks:

- 1. Conceptualization
 - 2. Specification
 - 3. Architecture
- 4. Component Production
 - 5. Application Assembly
 - 6. Certification
 - 7. Deployment

Developers

- Had to compete (traditional approach would not work).
- Needed accolades (Profiles had to include)
 - Statistics
 - Performance
 - Reliability
- Community based-peer review
 - determine winners
 - assess quality
