Our results...

- How satisfied do students feel?
 - the majority of students rated their feelings of satisfaction above a 7.
- What complaints do students have?
 - 23 of the 25 students complained about TRASH. Majority had problems with NOISE also.
- What housing did students want to be placed in?
 - 14 surveyed students wished to be placed in Wolf Creek, 9 in Bingham, and 2 in other unspecified housing.
- How safe do students feel?
 - 22 of the 25 students rated their feelings of safety above a 3.
- How many students have a mode of transportation?
 - 13 of the 25 students surveyed had a mode of transportation beyond the bus.

Our results continued...

- Did students feel that the bus runs on a frequent enough schedule?
 - more than half of students felt that the bus schedule was not frequent enough
- How did students feel about being fined for trash outside of their doors?
 - 15 of the 25 students felt that the \$25-per-bag fine was appropriate
- How do students feel about the distance from William Peace Univ. to Wolf Creek Apartments? (7 miles/nearly 20 minute drive or bus ride)
 - more than half of students believe that William Peace Univ. is too far from Wolf Creek Apartments.
- Students comments on advantages and disadvantages...
 - advantages: privacy, having personal room/bathroom space
 - disadvantages: distance from campus, feeling misled about how apartments would look, less community/closeness, waking up extra early
