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people live in rural areas, suffered a total of 14,364 suicide cases in the first nine months of 2010, according to state police. And in late 2010, more than 200 poor, debt-ridden residents of Andhra Pradesh killed themselves to escape payments or end the agonies their debt had triggered, according to media reports compiled by the government of the south Indian state. The state blamed microfinance companies — which give small loans intended to lift up the very poor — for fueling a frenzy of <u>overinclebtedness</u> and then <u>pressuring</u> borrowers so relentlessly that some took their own lives.

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a bus station in Hyderabad, 70km (43 miles) away from his rural home in the south-east Indian state of Andhra Pradesh, A government report said Mr. Moorthy had suffered a heart attack "due to pressure put by the micro-finance institutions for repayment". Ketadi Ramachandra Moorthy's family is struggling in debt. "He was so stressed out that he just collapsed and died," says his wife, K. Karuna, 36.
