Since 1950: 27-fold increase by volume mainly due to:




- · Open trade and investment policies:
 - uni-, bi-, multilateral and regional trade agreements (WTO, EEA ,NAFTA) eliminated or significantly reduced trade prohibiting measures.
- Developments in technology (drive down cost of transportation)
 - introduction of jet engine
 - containerization: standardization reduced cost of air and maritime transportation
 - IT revolution: simplifies coordination of production of product components across borders
