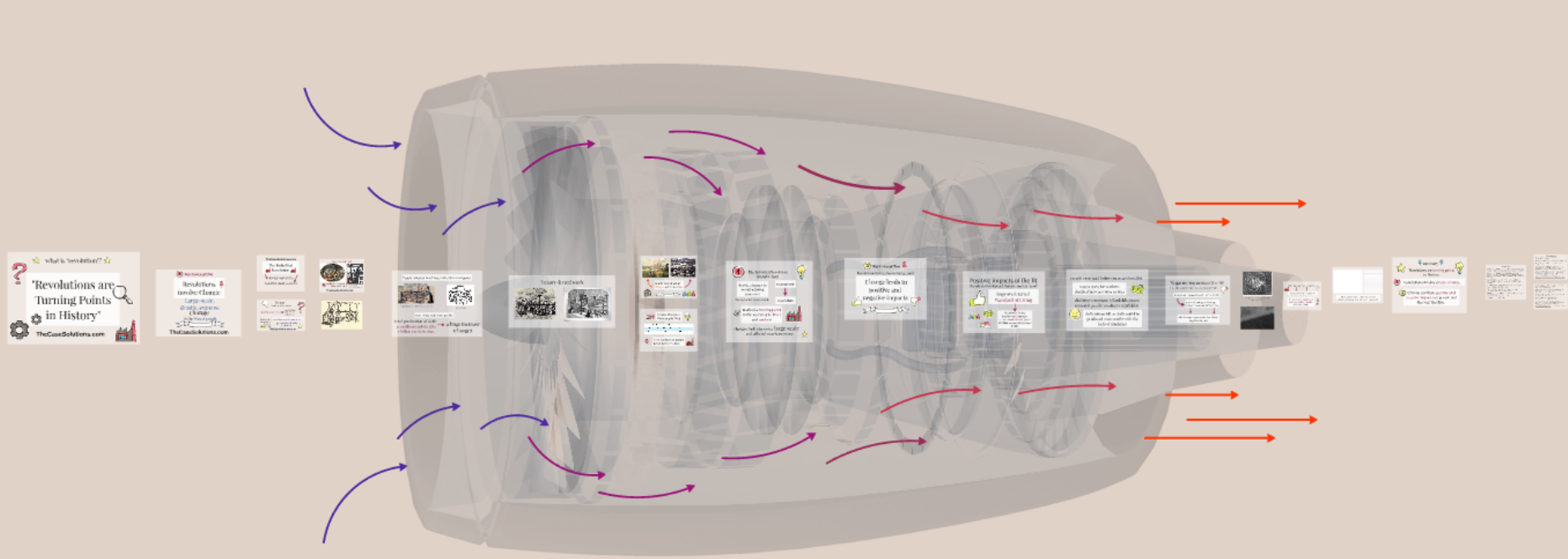

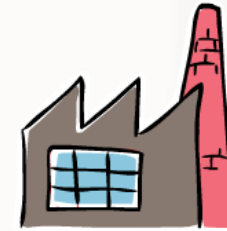

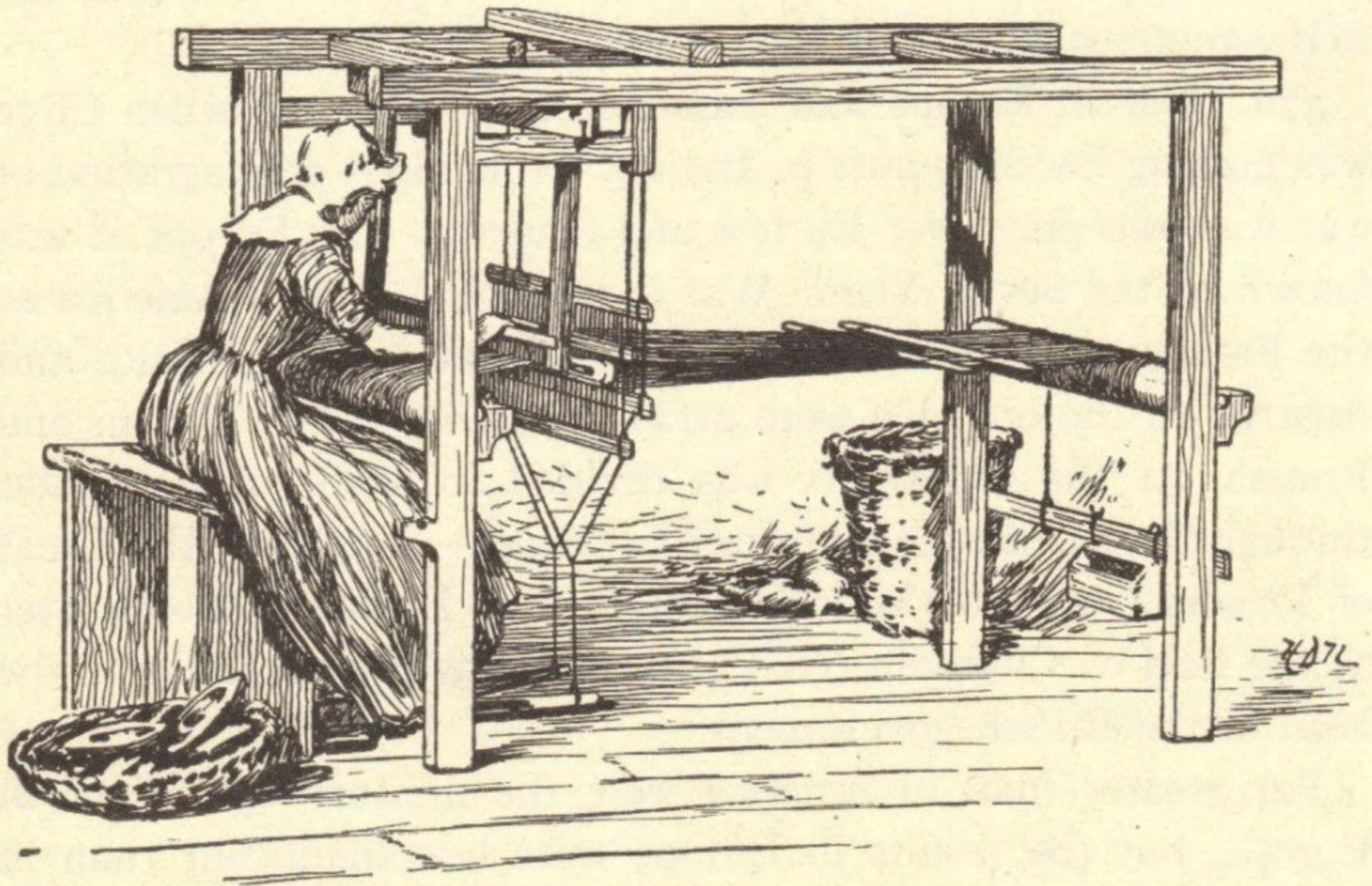
home-based work

machines were used

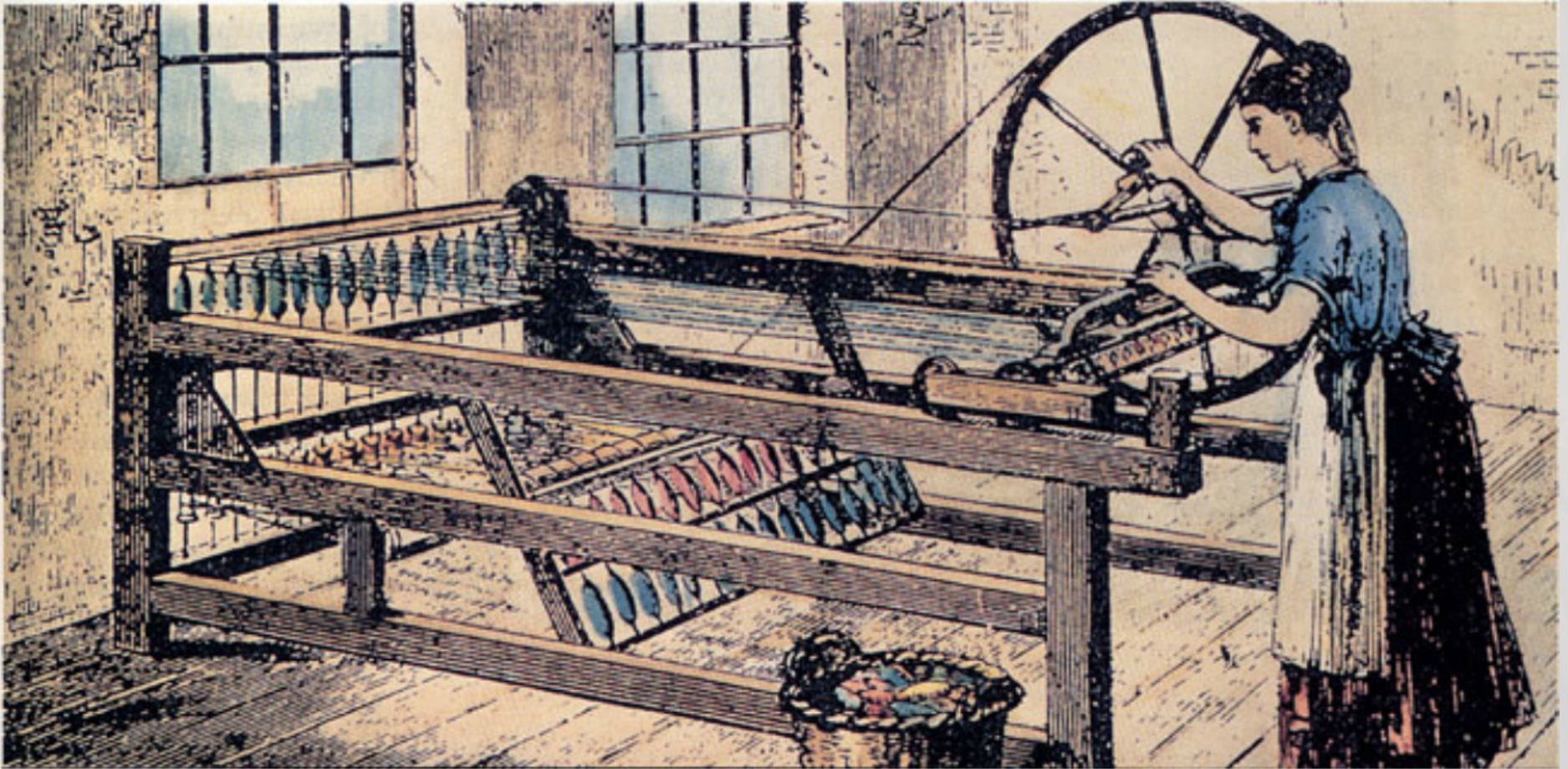
