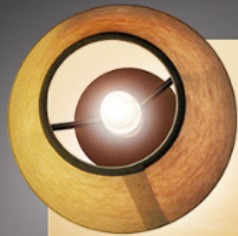

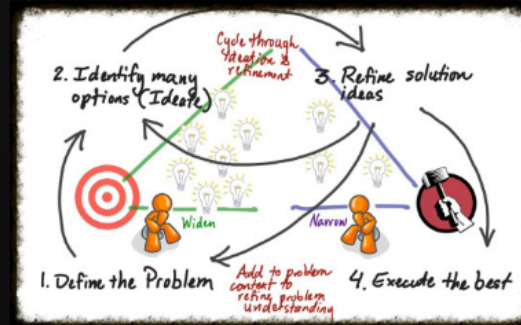

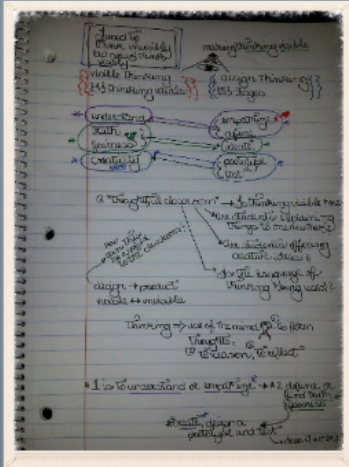

Design thinking begins with the end in mind, applies empathic understanding, creativity, prototypes, and tests.

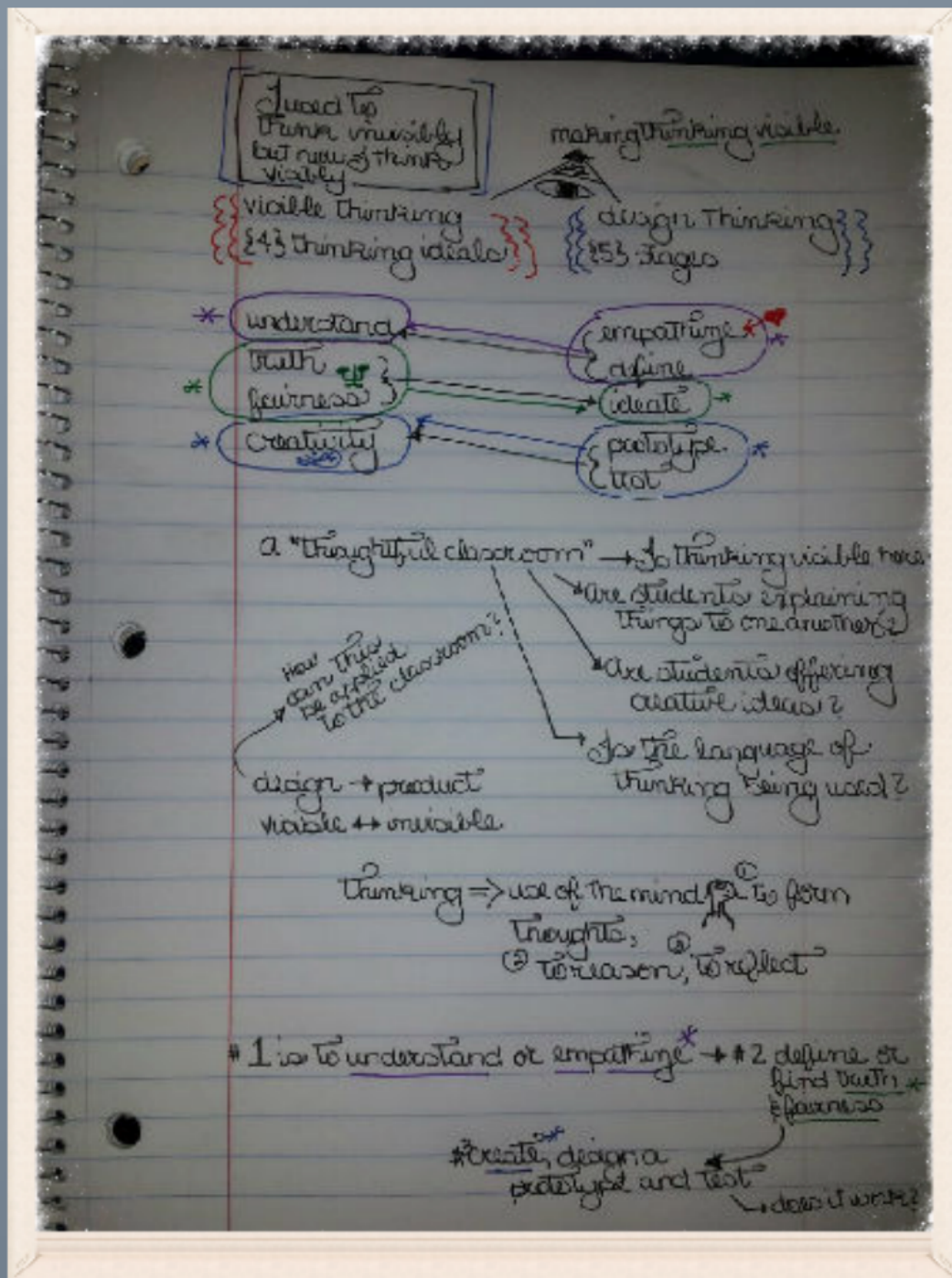

- Storytelling (e.g. Articulate Storyline)

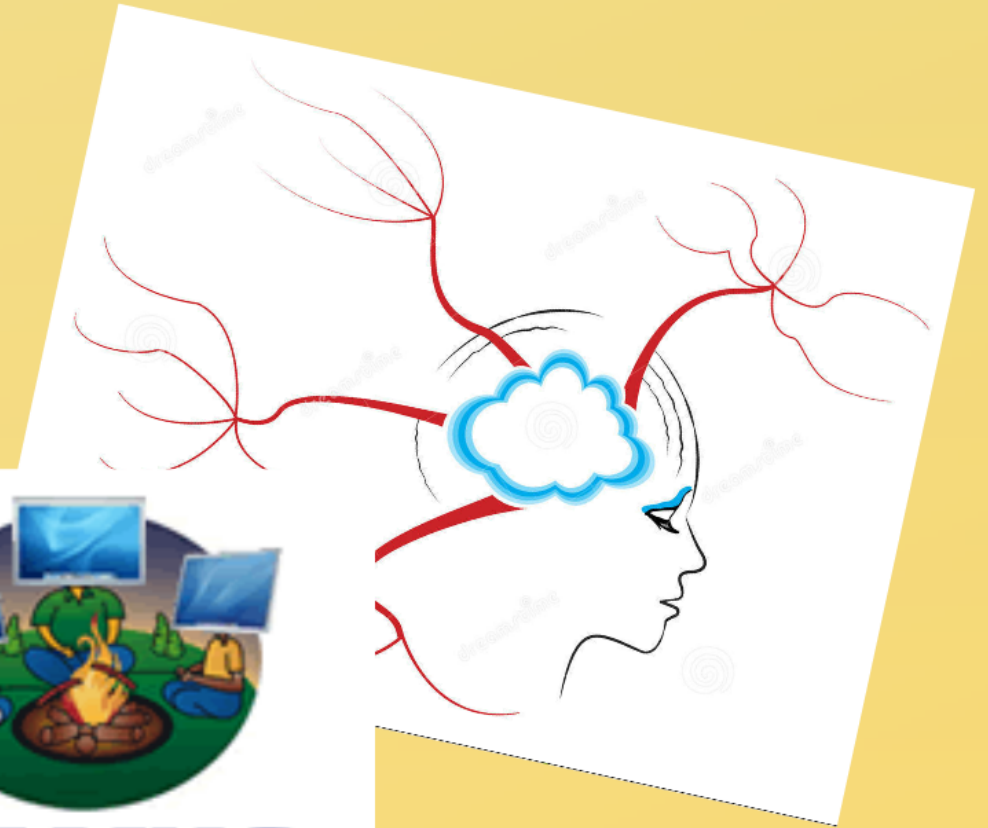

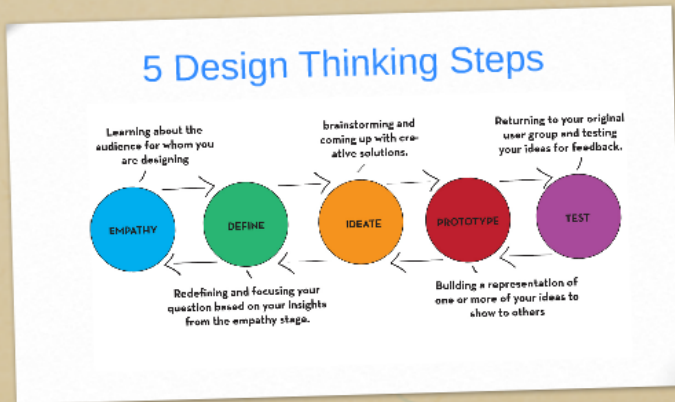

What Makes You Say That?	Interpretation with justification
Think-Pair-Share	Setting the stage for deeper inquiry
Circle of Viewpoints	Active reasoning and explanation
I Used to Think ... Now I Think ...	Exploring diverse perspectives
See-Think-Wonder	Reflecting on how and why our thinking has changed
Critique, Shapes, Lines	Assessing works of art and other meaningful things
