Built to Order

"A style of order fulfillment where production is commenced once a confirmed order is received"

Most suitable for:

• Highly customizable,

• Low-volume products, or

• Expensive holding inventory

Problems

- Susceptible to market demands
- · Can not fully utilize manufacturing capacity



Benefits

- Provide customer with the exact requirements
- Reduce cost and risk to holding inventory

Solution

- Proactive demand management
- Find the 'perfect' Decoupling point (Identifying which suppliers should be BTO, and which should be BTS)
