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Potential Solutions & Courses of Action

- As stated in AFI 36-2254V1, Commanders may grant an excused absence of a member based on the member's submission of adequate justification within 30 days prior to or 30 days following the missed UTA. Do not authorize excusals outside the 30-day period. At the fourth unexcused absence, an automated participation status report is generated.
- Potential solutions for moral: incentives, team-building exercise, future annual tours, awards & decorations and recognition
- Ask for assistance from other units to support the various combat and humanitarian mission by way of using upward communication to our Chain of Command
- Conduct a meeting with lower management expressing motivation and inspiring members; reminding them our service before self. Communicating the importance of tardiness and reschedules as well as the team building concept.
- Address the importance of military bearing and rank structure. Utilizing the chain of command and utilizing AFI 36-2618
