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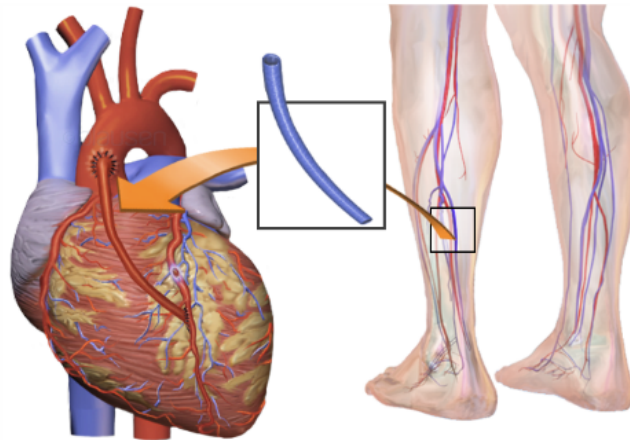
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Open Heart Quintuple Bypass Surgery

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Physical Assessment/Charting by Exception

- Strong heartbeat, not +4 bounding pulse
- 18 cm sternal wound, approximated, scabbing, no significant erythema/exudate
- 1-2.5 cm wounds approximated, scabbing, no significant erythema/exudate
 - Medial aspect of right leg
 - Medial aspect of right popliteal
 - Medial aspect of right inguinal

Priority Nursing Diagnoses

- Cognitive/Perceptual (Carpenter's)
 1. Knowledge deficit related to new wound care evidenced by verbalizing having "no idea" about how to care for the wound
 2. "being good as new", and wanting to return to normal ADLs
- Health Perception/Management
- Nonverbal/Verbal

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Significant Functional Health Patterns (FHPs)

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- Health Perception/Management
 - i. "New heart"
 - ii. Feels able to return to normal and more
 - iii. Does not feel tired with exertion but vitals increase significantly
- Nutrition/Metabolic
 - i. "Whole ingredients"
 - ii. Bacon
 - iii. Temporary versus permanent diet change
- Cognitive/Perceptual
 - i. Did not finish college
 - ii. New self
 - iii. Surgeon: "Good as new"



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
