Colombia Information (Cont.)

- Predominant Religion(s): Catholicism is the main religion
- up to 75% of people there practice.
- They do have freedom of Religion and can choose where to worship.
- Education System: Colombia has an elevenyear system of elementary and secondary education that has five years of elementary education, four years of lower secondary education and two years of upper secondary education.
- There are three levels of university studies (College): professional (professional/ undergraduate), maestría/magister (master's degree), and doctor.
