Explaining my change in social media

- Changing social media and improving the way we use it would be on a **micro-level** because it focuses on individuals and their interactions. For example, explanations of social life and social structure are found at the individual level or in social interactions.
- In modern societies very different kinds of people are thrown together and expected to live together. It is not at all clear what holds them together when they are so different. Durkheim says that "**organic solidarity**" holds them together.
- By this, he means that people need each other in an economic sense. They depend on one another to keep their economy functioning as in the functionalist theory. This binds them together even though they do not hold all of their values in common.
- **By** improving the way everyone uses social media in the society, our **value consensus** would be to use it for the purpose of good things such as more people using it for business inquiries, and strengthening our economy.

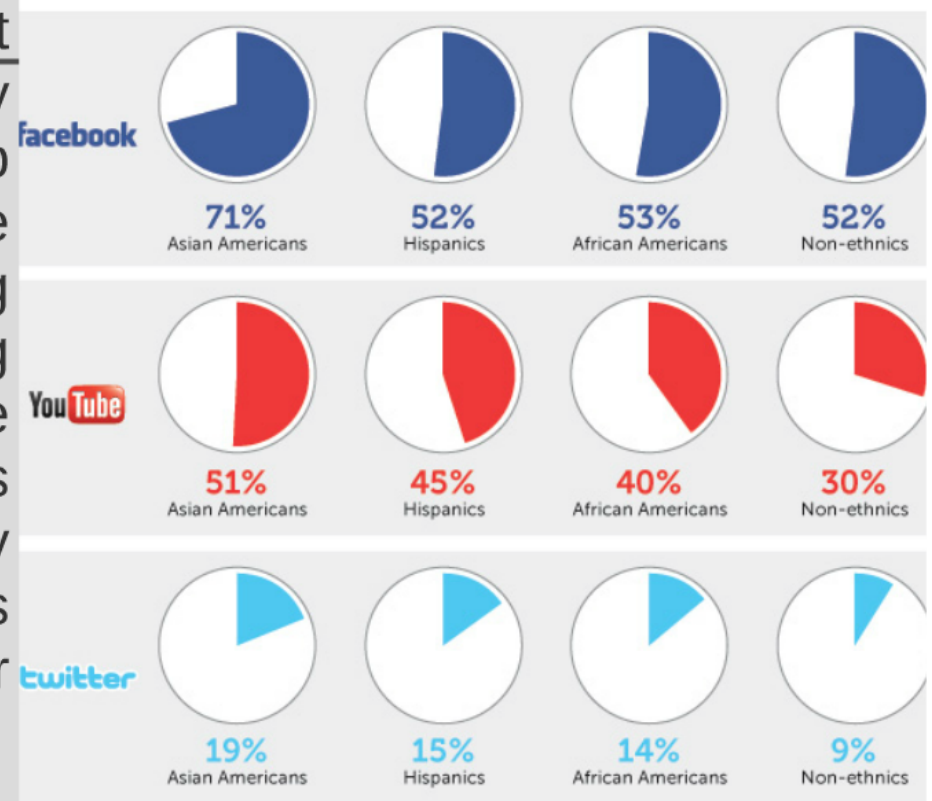
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How does diversity play a role in my new society?

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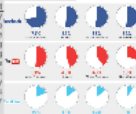
