

Introduction

Definitions

oppressed: subject to harsh treatment

concubinage: a woman who lives with a man but has lower status than his wife/wives

notion: a conception of or belief about something

misogyny: dislike of, contempt for, or ingrained prejudice against women

Definitions

patriarchy: a system of society in which the father or eldest male is head of the family

emancipation: the fact or process of being set free from legal, social, or political restrictions; liberation.

subordinate: lower in rank or position



Confucianism

- Confucius's teachings created the belief that women were inferior to men.
- Women were expected only to serve their families and bear children.
- Unacceptable for women to have ambitions of their own.
- They were pressured into many things like arranged marriages, foot binding, and the duty to have a son.



- Marriage was deemed as the most important factor of a woman's life.
- They were either arranged by the families of the to-be bride and groom, or by matchmakers.
- Young brides were frequently abused by their husbands and mother-in-laws.
- If a woman's husband died, she would be stuck in the household of her in-laws or if she had a son she would have to obey him.
