- Educational equity is a measure of achievement, fairness, and opportunity in education.
- The study of such equity is often linked with the study of excellence and equity.
- Dependent on two factors, that are also dependent on each other, are:
 - Fairness
 - Inclusion



- is the nations oldest and largest federally funded program
- enacted in 1965 under the Elementary and Secondary Education Act.

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- Designed to attract voluntary enrollment by offering special programs or curricula that appeal to students from more than one neighborhood to create a mix of ethnic and racial groups.
- There are more than 1,000 magnet schools functioning in public-school districts.



- The theme-based education per school promoting personalization.
- No entrance criteria, but to embrace the mission of the magnet school.
- Random computer based history systems for admission.
- Serve all students including ELL and students receiving special education services.
- Diversity is very important; promotes higher-level cognitive and social learning.
- Based more parental and community involvement.
- Teachers are licensed in the areas they teach, and are "highly specialized" through specific theme based training and professional development.

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Offers: high school, middle school, elementary school, and preschool.

- Enrichment Academy is a home school program which provides families with support and guidance by offering enrichment and social opportunities.
- Also offers STEAM and coding curricula, allowing students to extend their learning beyond the classroom.
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- Preschool: full day, 8:30-11:30, open to all ages 3-5.
- Full day: 8:30-11:30, open to all ages 3-5.
- Half day: 8:30-11:30, open to all ages 3-5.
- High school: 8:30-11:30, open to all ages 11-12.
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Process of admission:

- Employment that all students must have a Christian faith commitment to attend.
- Students must be a resident of the state of North Carolina.

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What is the purpose of Title 1 funds?

How are the funds used?

- Title 1 funds rests with each school.
- Funds can be used to improve curriculum, instructional activities, counseling, parental involvement, increase staff and program improvement.

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Environmental Academy of Research Technology & Earth Sciences

- Magnet School for K-6 students (540 students) offers a challenging, Common Core standards curriculum that is integrated with environmental science and technology.
- Students use the Exploration Center and lab table, and an innovative outdoor learning program.
- Curriculum is an integrated, interdisciplinary process in isolated subjects.

In the US, a public school is a school that is maintained at public expense for the education of the children of a community or districts and that constitutes a part of a system of free public education commonly including primary and secondary schools.

Transportation:

Free based home to school transportation program for students enrolled.

Registration: Documents required: proof of birth, proof of residency, proof of residency, immunization records.

Funding:

about half the funding for public schools is through state taxes, a portion of which is provided to private schools.



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- Some of the programs that have been developed to help students improve math and reading skills and to develop well rounded successful students are:

- Full time literacy coach to diagnose and monitor students' needs.
- A Family Math Fair to show parents how to help their children in math.

- Parent Education Classes and Parent Involvement Opportunities.

Private Schools



-are schools which are founded, conducted, and maintained by a private group rather than by the government, usually charging tuition and often following a particular philosophy, viewpoint, etc.

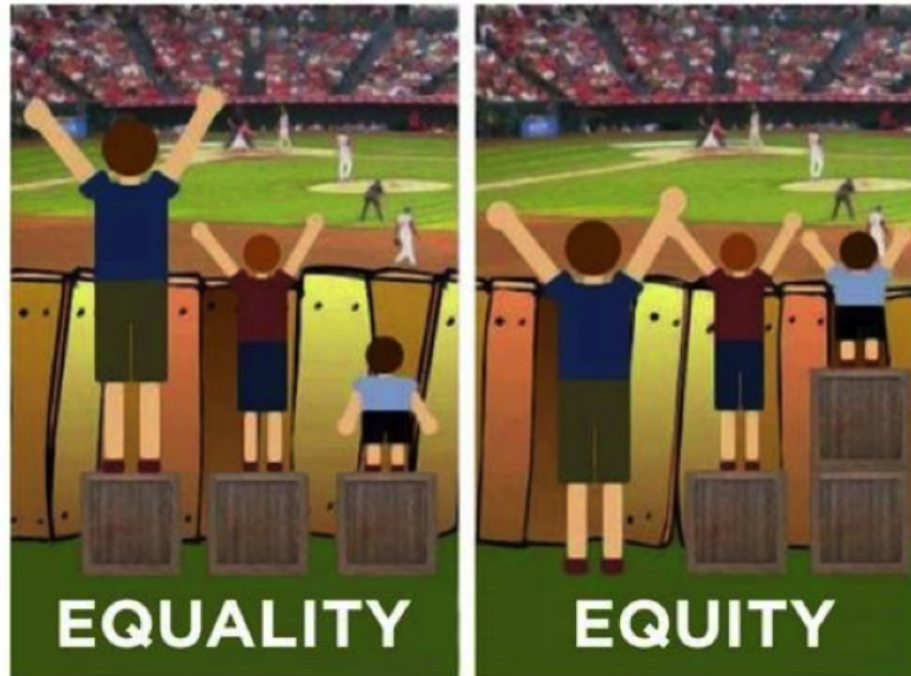

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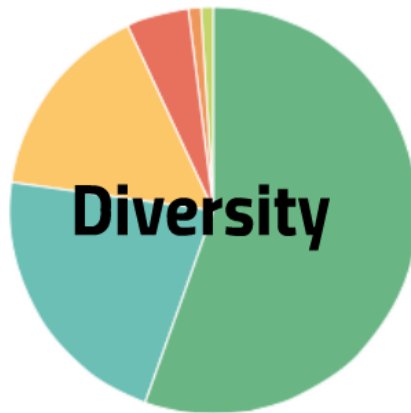
