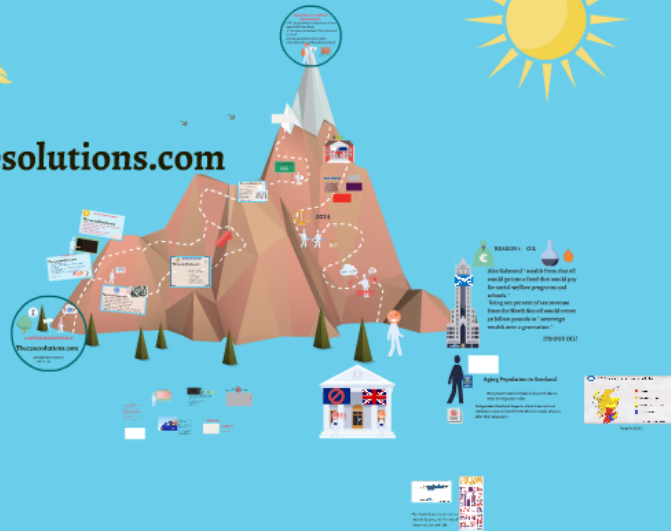

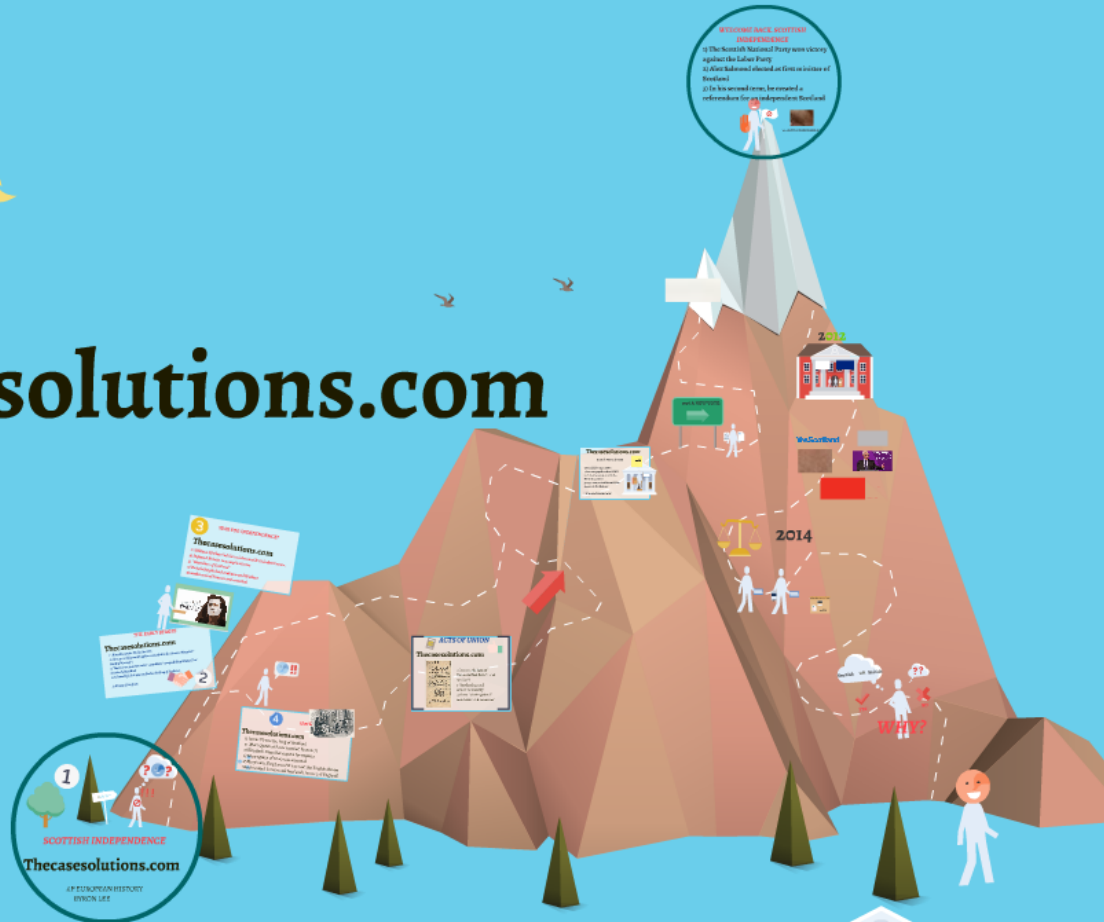

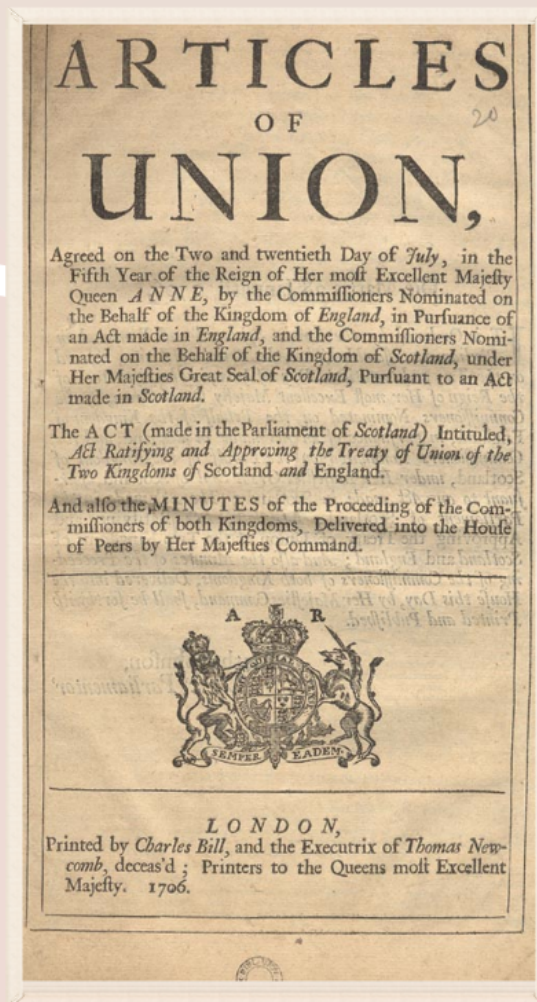
- 1) James VI was the king of Scotland

## Scottish National Party

- 1) Founded in 1934 (SNP)

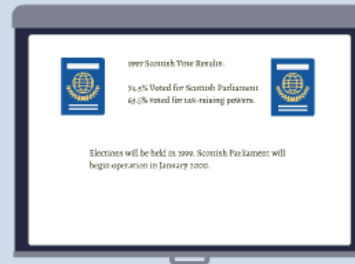


# 1997 Scotland Vote
