The first inventor of the telegraph is Samuel Morse. He was born April 27, 1791, in Charleston, Massachusetts.

### Where...?

Invented in London. Also from the U.S.A. Never more than physical site of each other, usually within 2-4 miles.

### When...?

It was developed in the early 1800's around 1830-1840. In 1844 Samuel Morse sent his first telegraph message. Also in 1866 a telegraph line had been laid across the Atlantic ocean from the U.S to Europe.
