So, what is elder abuse you ask?

"Any knowing, intentional, or negligent act by a caregiver or any other person that causes harm or a serious risk of harm to a vulnerable adult."

## Legalities

The Betts v. Goffe Amendment (73-918) states any person has the duty to report if there is any suspicion of neglect and abuse. Legal charges can be brought against anyone who withholds such data to protect abuse. The Department of Health has an abuse registry.

## Legalities

**Federal Level:**  
Elder Justice Act instituted in 2010 - provides funding for prevention, detection and intervention of elder abuse.

**Abuse**  
The Department of Health has an abuse registry.

**A Little History Lesson**  
1974 first cases reported → 1980  
Congress general de la Cruz → 1982  
Congress enactment of legislation → 1989  
Claude Pepper → 2002 Elder Justice Act  
introduced → 2008 Elder Justice Act  
enacted → 2010, EJA became a Law

**Types of Abuse:**  
Physical, Emotional, Financial, Neglect (self neglect, "starvation" Abuse/neglect)

**WHY should this issue be addressed?**

Because for every reported case of elder abuse or neglect about 75 go unreported. That's a whopping 92% of cases that go unreported!!! due to social constraint and physical limitations, the abused elderly cannot find the means to help themselves.

however, this *violent crime* is often in the *silence*\*

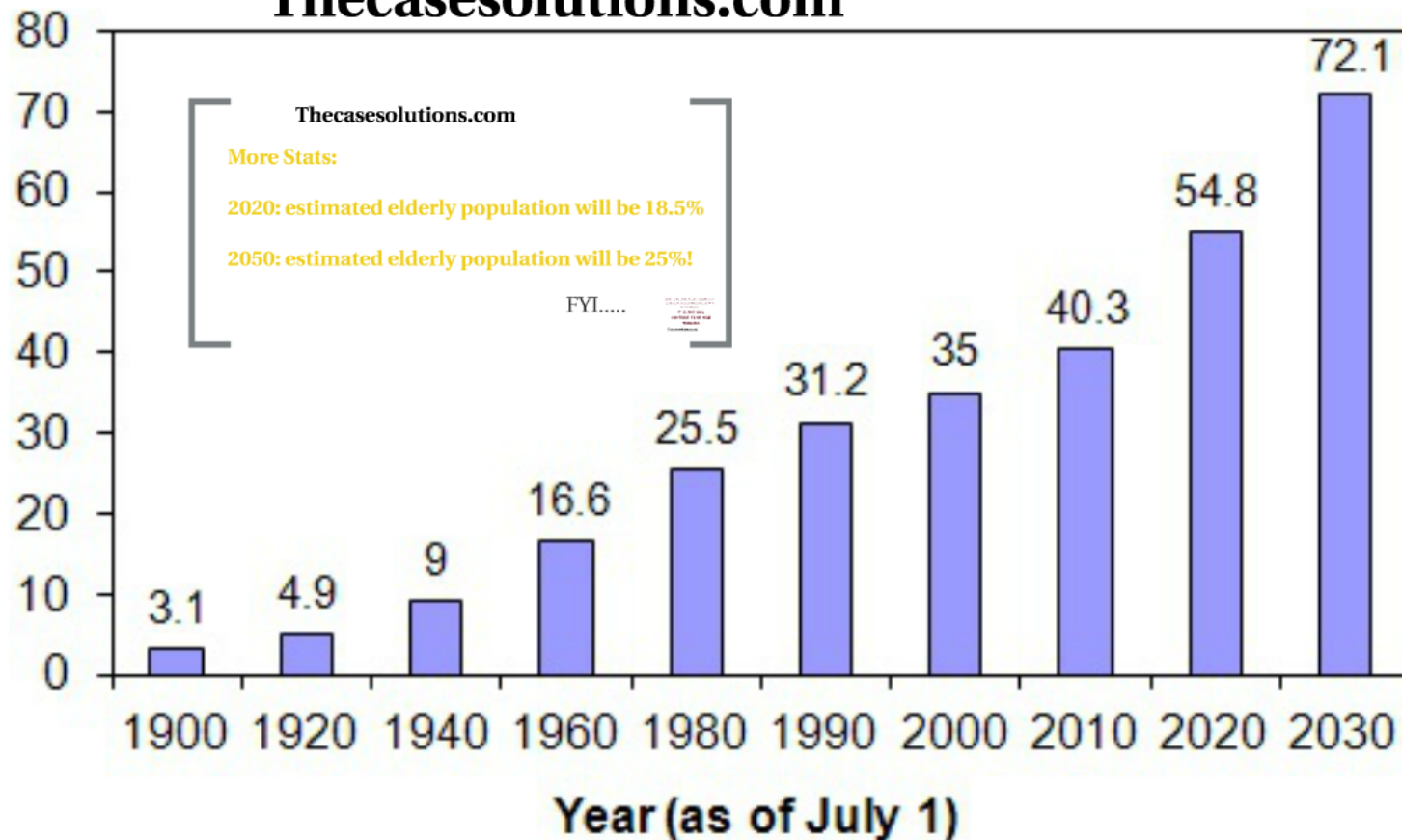
