Xi'an International University: The Growth of Private Universities in China, Chinese Version



Xi'an Jiaotong - Liverpool University (XJTLU) an independent university accredited by University of Liverpool



Why?



Part of Liverpool's aspiration to be a "global university" with international students in Liverpool and students studying for Liverpool degrees overseas.

Key to this is XJTLU: "NOT a campus, a real new Chinese university"

Where?

XJTLU is based in Suzhou in China which is about 80km west of Shanghai



How does it work?

Students can choose to do their whole degree in China or follow a 2+2 route.

The 2+2 route students spend the first 2 years in China and then transfer to Liverpool to complete their final 2 years.

They start in the 2nd year of degrees in Liverpool. When they graduate they receive two degrees.

XJTLU offers a different way of teaching to other higher education institutions in China. Prepares students for the UK education system but in a familiar setting.

Students take part in group work, develop presentation & communication skills. Focus on transferable skills.
