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## *Academics*

- 36 majors offered ranging from various types of engineering to psychology and sociology.
- Everyone graduates with a BA in science
- Internships and study abroad opportunities as you progress
- Small class environment (15-18 students)
- Civilian and military staff
- Rigorous academic program
- Everyone required to take a set amount of classes in engineering

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## ***Military***

- Military Science Program- consists of three 40 lesson courses that prepare cadets for tactical leadership. The program is outcome-based and teaches sound decision-making under pressure.
- Military training during the Academic Year and the Summer Term.
- Summer programs (airborne and air assault school)
- Opportunities to stand alongside a unit

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## *Extra Curricular Activities*

- Over 30 clubs, such as Debate, Model UN, & Cyber Defense
- Everyone is required to play a sport
  - NCAA Sports
  - Club Sports- equestrian, boxing, water polo
  - Company athletics
- Band program

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## Tuition

- Free if you get in but the effort put into getting in is much more than any other University
  - Many elements to take into consideration
- Commissioned as a second lieutenant in the Army and serve for five years on active duty
- If you choose to depart the Army after five years, you will be required to serve three years in the Inactive Ready Reserve (IRR).
