




HOW TO AVOID THE DISEASE.

Evidence seems to prove that this is a germ disease, apread principally by human contact, chiefly coughing, sneezing or spitting. avoid persons having colds, which means avoiding crowds-common drinking cups, roller towels, etc. Keep up your bodily strength by plenty of exercise in the open air, and good food.
