





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The World Food Program

Initially, the World Food Program began as a three-year project in 1963.

Ever since then, the WFP expanded to the organization it is today.

The World Food Program is branch of the United Nations and the world's largest humanitarian organization that addresses hunger and promoting food security.

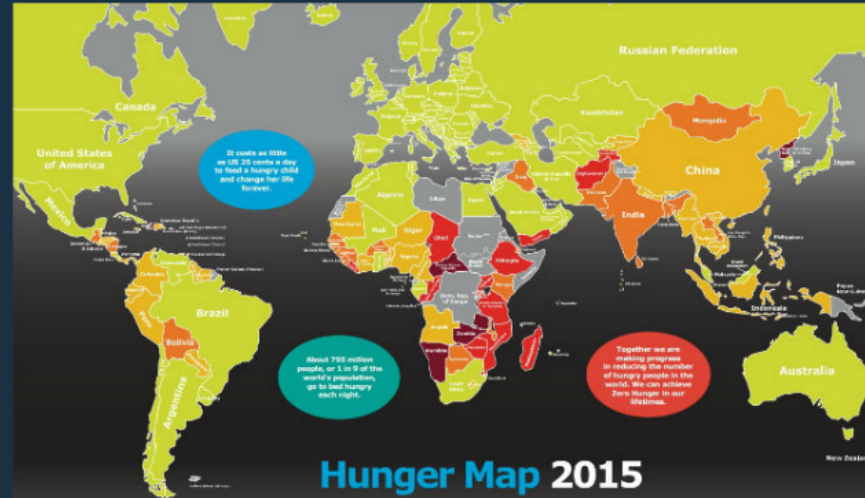


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Significance

Approximately 795 million people in the world are chronically malnourished.

Every year, consumers in industrialized countries waste almost as much food as the entire net food production of *sub-Saharan Africa*



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Findings

- Asia is the continent with the most hungry people - two thirds of the total population
→ Then why does the World Food Program focuses mainly on African Countries?
- If women farmers had the same access to resources as men, the number of hungry in the world could be reduced by up to 150 million.
- Sub-Saharan Africa is the region with the highest prevalence (percentage of population) of hunger. One person in four there is undernourished.
- The United States wastes enough food to end hunger in Sub-Saharan Africa

The WFP's mission is to end global hunger.

HOW EFFECTIVE IS THE WFP IN CARRYING OUT THEIR MISSION?

THEIR MISSION

1. Save lives and protect livelihoods in emergencies;
2. Support food security and nutrition and (re)build livelihoods in fragile settings and following emergencies;
3. enable people, communities and countries to meet their own food and nutrition needs;
4. Reduce undernutrition

THE RESULTS (2013)

- 1) 85 million people reached in 75 countries
(795 million in the world are classified as hungry)
- 2) 3.1 million metric tons of food was delivered to hungry people
- 3) 15.1 million people received food as an incentive to build assets or attend training = **roughly 19% of those reached**
- 4) Levels of acute malnutrition stabilized or fell in 90% of projects
