

- -PBS made an episode on frontline: Life and death in assistant living.
- -Talks negatively about Emeritus senior living homes
- -Report came from looking at 3 out of over 480 of the facilities.

What are the business organizational or reputational outcomes?


- -This made the company look extremely bad
- -Residents families filed lots of law suits on anything they saw wrong with the facility
- -Families worried more about the care that they were providing
- -Emeritus went into dept and was bought out by Brookdale senior living (2014)
