


Coca-Cola is headquartered in Atlanta, Georgia.




### Who Does It Reach?

Reach encompasses + 200 countries worldwide across 6 operating regions: Eurasia and Africa, Europe, Latin America, North America, Pacific and Bottling Investments - In addition to corporate.

#### Why Was It Created?

- Coca-Cola began in 1886 when an Atlanta pharmacist, Dr. John S.
  Pemberton, created a distinctive tasting soft drink that could be sold at soda fountains. He created a flavored syrup, took it to his neighborhood pharmacy, where it was mixed with carbonated water and deemed "excellent"
- He fought in the Civil War, and at the end of the war he decided he wanted to invent something that would bring him commercial success.



### How Long Has It Been Around?

It was first introduced in 1886, so today it has been around for 127 years and is still going strong.
