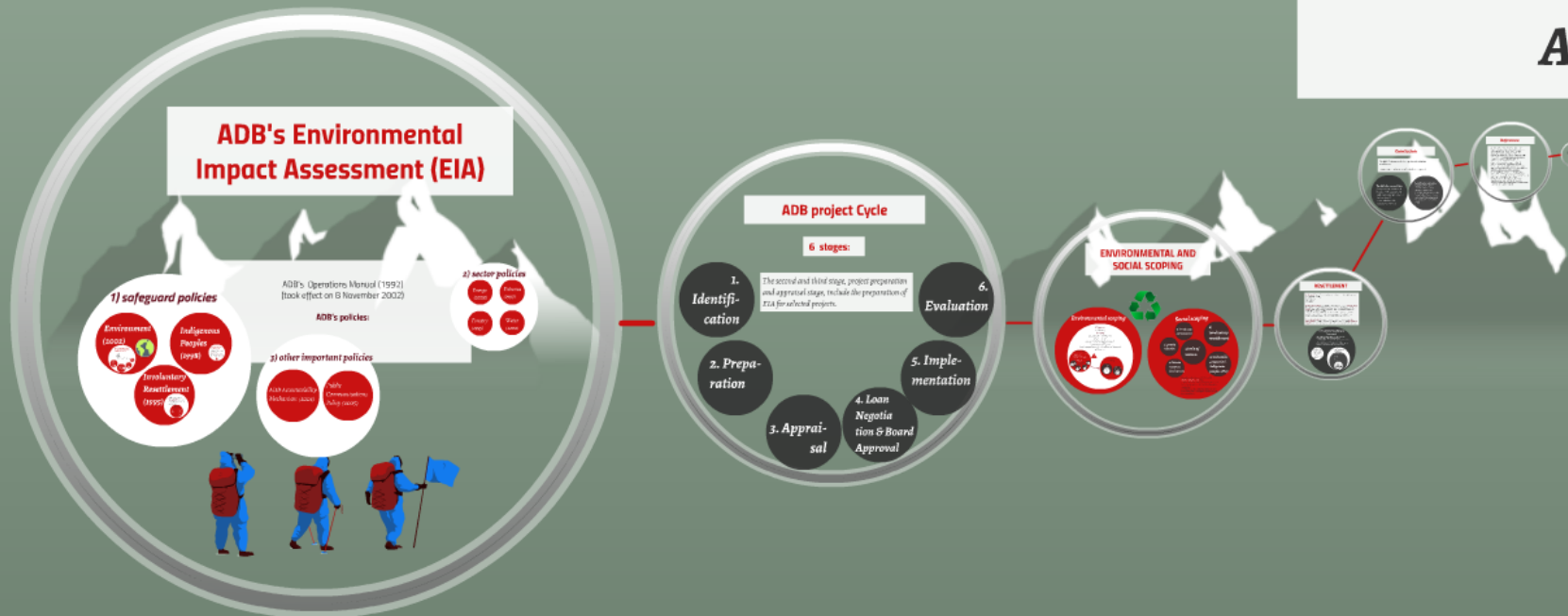

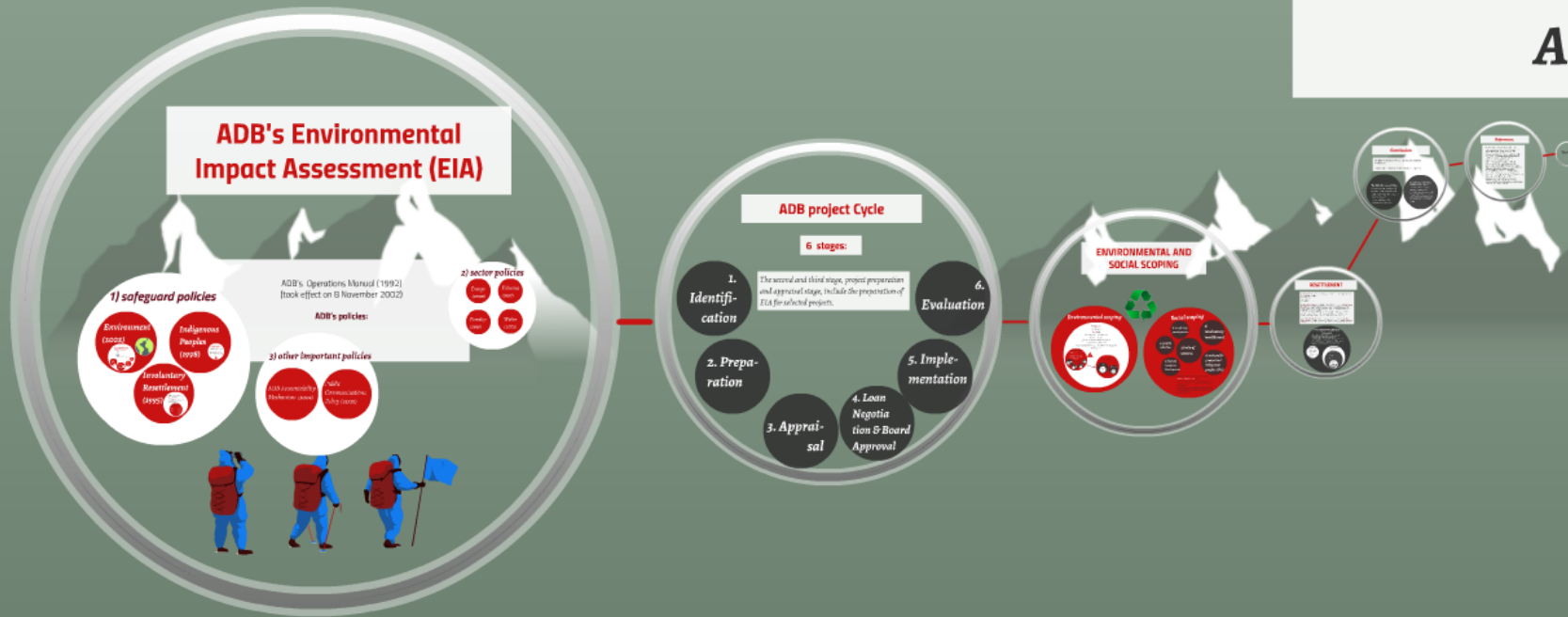

Indigenous Peoples Rights Act (IPRA) or RA 8371

IPRA is a landmark law that recognizes and protects the rights of indigenous peoples in the Philippines. It provides a legal basis for the government to protect and promote the rights of indigenous peoples in the exercise of their self-determining rights.

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Involuntary Resettlement (1995)
