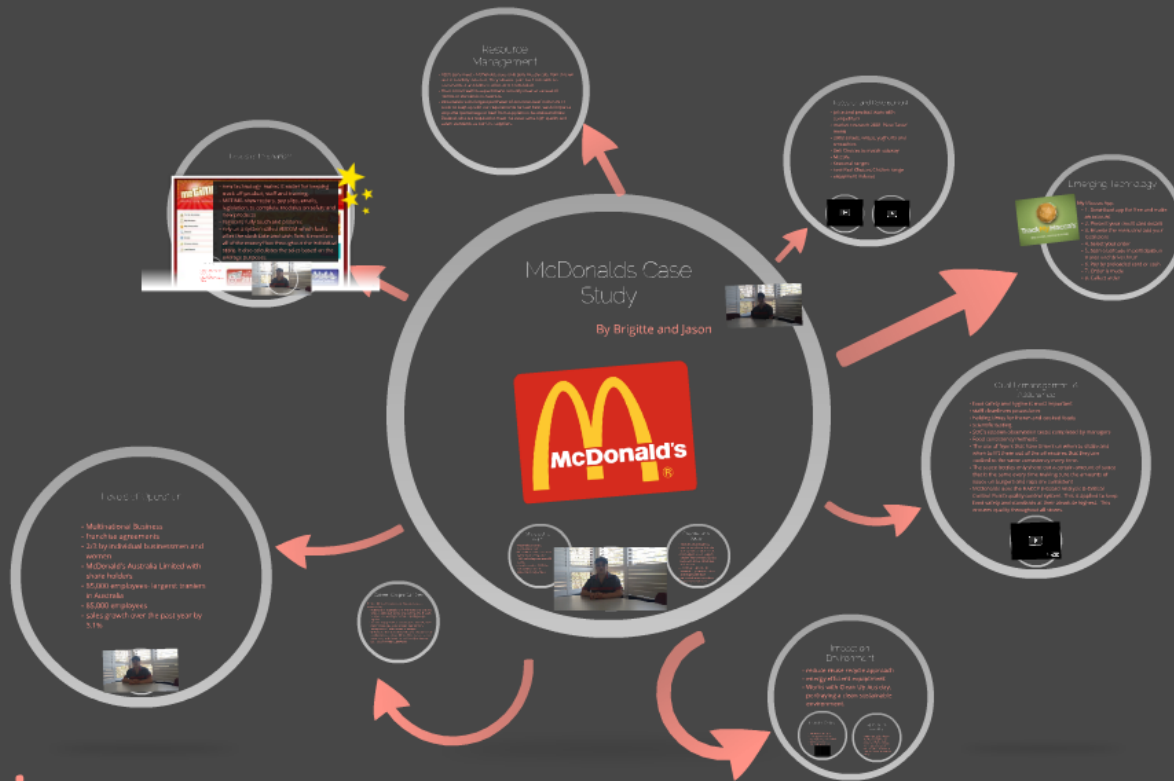
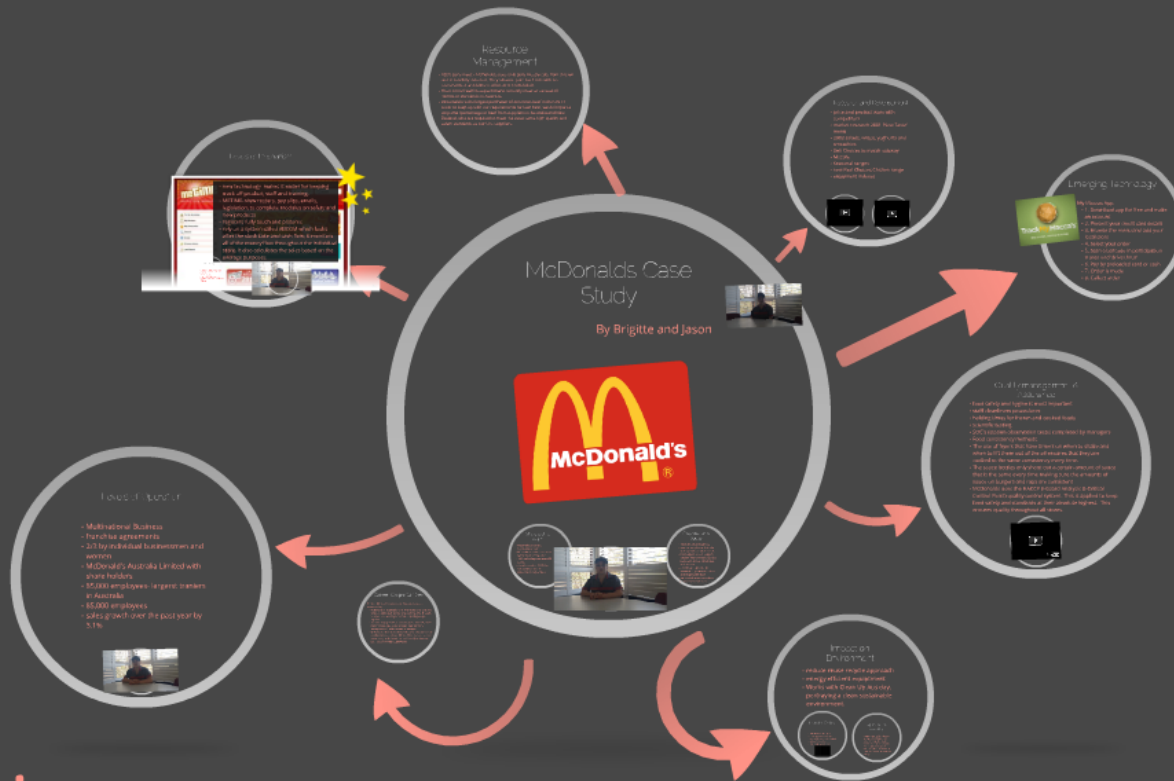

- McDonald's Brothers Hamburgers 1954
- Mike and Ike machine salesman by the name of Ray Kroc
- 1960 he had opened over 200 stores
- \$3 million and by 1966 the company became the McDonald's Corporation
