What are ethics?

1. Well-founded standards of right and wrong that prescribe what humans ought to do, usually in terms of rights, obligations, benefits to society, fairness, or specific virtues.
2. The continuous effort of studying our own moral beliefs and our moral conduct, and striving to ensure that we, and the institutions we help to shape, live up to standards that are reasonable and solidly-based.



Ethics in the Workplace

- A set of formal and informal standards of conduct that people use to guide their behavior at work

The study of what constitutes right and wrong, good or bad, human conduct in a business context
