-medications are oral or topical

-medications are being administered by a board of
education employee

-in agreement with any other law or rule

An unlicensed person may help an able-bodied person with their medications in a non-health care setting by:

1. remind the person
 2. give the container of medication to the individual
 3. remove the medication from its container
- ★ unlicensed person cannot give the medication orally, by injection, or any other way★
