Ethical Dilemma: Surrogacy Valid?

What is Surrogacy

A type of assisted reproduction where a woman is impregnated and carries the baby full term with the intent of giving it away to an individual/couple wanting a child

Traditional Surrogacy

- Surrogate mother is artificially inseminated with her own egg fertilized
- Biologically connected to mother

Gestational Surrogacy

- Surrogate mother impregnated with fertilized egg from donor
- Biologically not connected to mother
- More common today
