In 1976 she opened a catering business that she ran from her farmhouse basement.

Ten years after opening her business, it became a million dollar enterprise.

In 1982, her first book, a cookbook, was released.



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Later that year, she became an editor and a columnist for HSN.

Sadly, as Martha's career prospered, her family life didn't. In 1989, her and Andrew Stewart divorced.
