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Public school in the 1800's



- to increase the quality of public schools in the 19th century, Horace Mann made the school year longer
- raised the teacher's salaries
- Mann also created colleges for teachers so they were better trained to teach
- before he lengthen the school year, it was only 10 weeks long

Public schools today



- public school is completely payed for by tax payer dollars
- for many students, public school doesn't meet their expectations so they attend non- public schools

Non-public schools in the 1800's



- these schools were founded by the Roman Catholic Church
- only rich kids went these schools

Non-public schools today



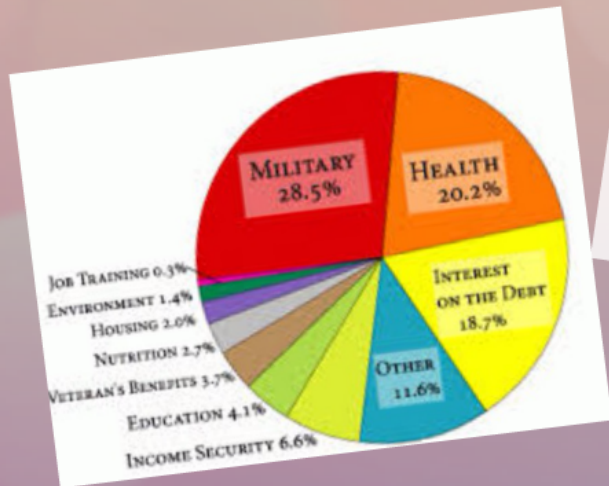
- every kind of person is allowed to access private schools
