# *Introduction*

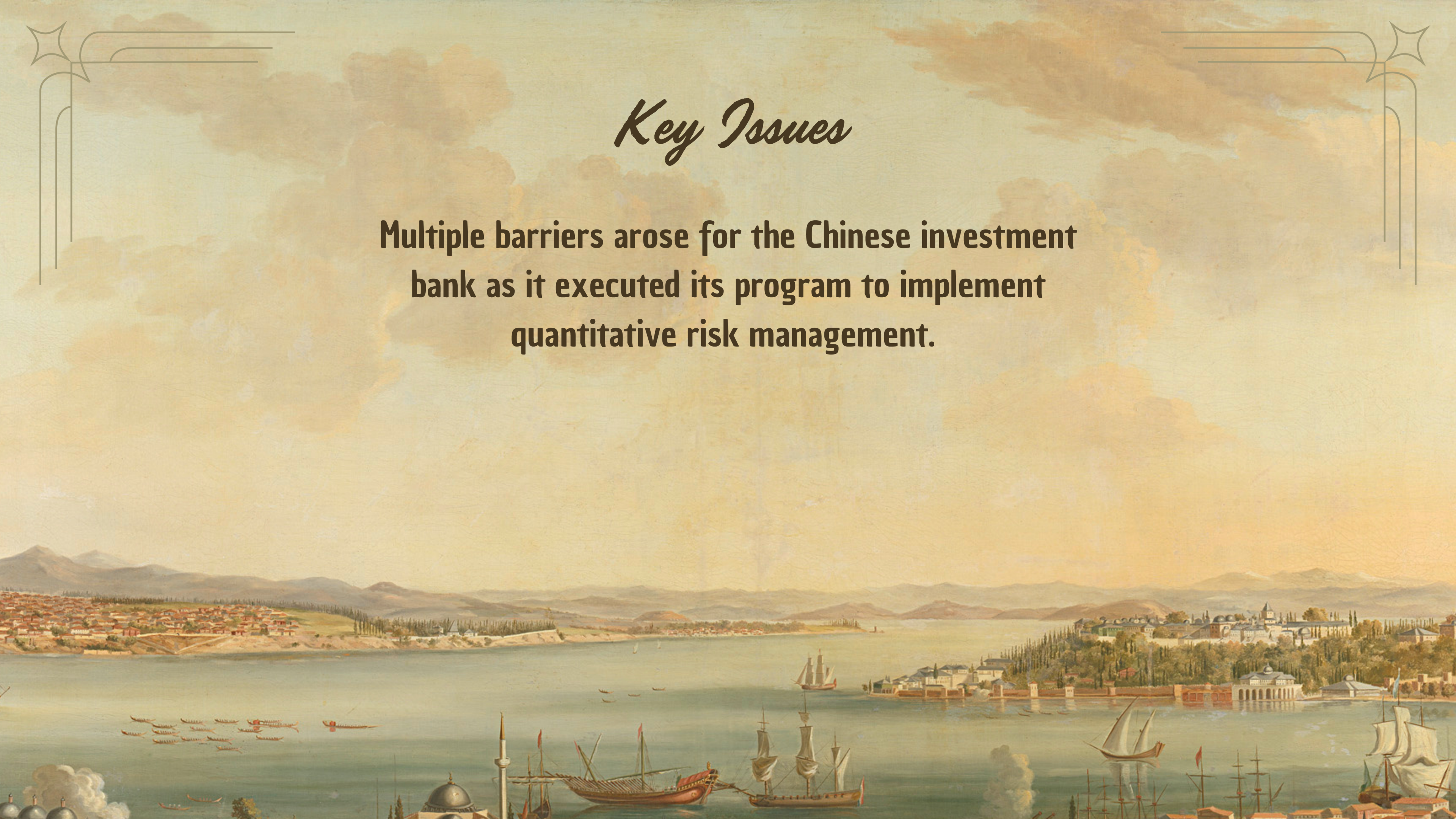

# *Implementation*

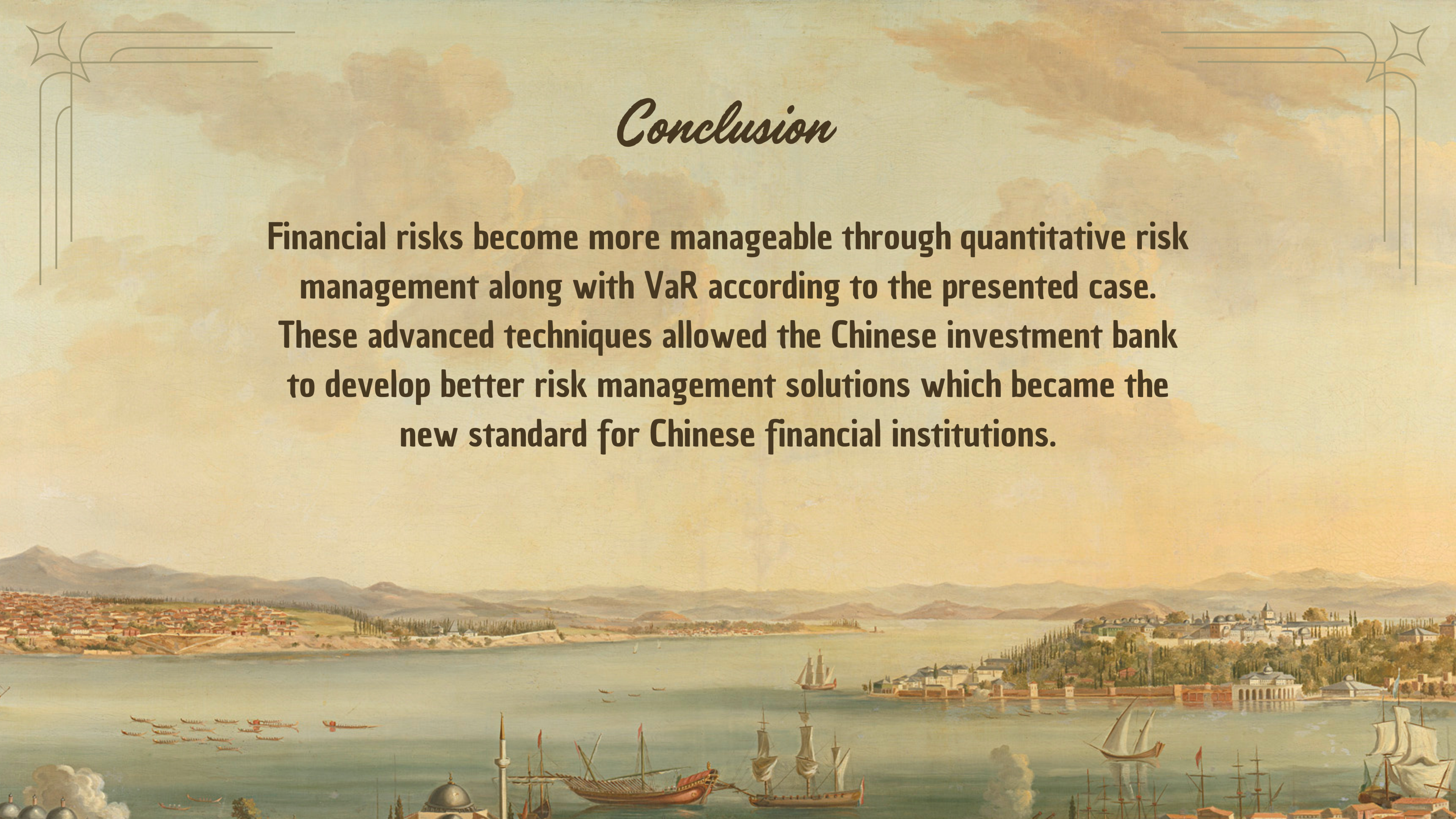
